From Fr. Robert. . .

God is not static, nor is He distant

Today we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, the central mystery of the Catholic faith. God is not static, nor is He distant. He is an eternal fire of Love. The Father pours out His Love to the Son, the Son returns His Love to the Father, and the Love between them is so perfect, so real, so eternal that it is a distinct person of the Holy Trinity: the Holy Spirit. This love has overflowed from the heart of the Trinity and become accessible to us. " Hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us" (Rom 5:5).

What does this Divine Love want in return? To be loved by us. Many of the Church's saintly mystics throughout the ages, after coming to taste of the love of the Trinity, have lamented, "LOVE IS NOT LOVED!" Indeed we find ourselves loving worldly things so much more than God. Yet, the good news is that God is merciful love and He desires to increase the fire of Love, the Holy Spirit in our hearts so that we can love Him as He deserves. The following is a prayer which the Angel of Fatima taught to the three shepherd children and which is a beautiful way we can return the immense Love with which the Blessed Trinity has loved us.

*Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifferences by which He is offended. And through the infinite merits of His Most Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of Thee the conversion of poor sinners.*
