#### From Fr. Robert. . .


Today marks another change in the Mass schedule of our parishes in Thermopolis and Worland. I'm hopeful that this will better accommodate more people, but at the same time, I know it will inconvenience others. I just want to thank everyone in advance for your patience and flexibility. It's hard to change decades-old habits, and I'm grateful for your understanding.

The Mass is the most precious thing we have as Catholics. It is there that we renew our covenant with the Lord. It is there that we encounter Him in Word and Sacrament. It is there that we offer to God right and fitting worship.

Fr. Bryce Lungren in his recent book, "The Catholic Cowboy Way" writes a chapter called, "Fight for Mass." In it he explains, "If nothing else, the Mass is worth fighting for with all our strength just to say thanks to God. The Mass is a thanksgiving offering we are making to God the Father for the *life, death, and Resurrection* of Jesus Christ, His Son. Gratitude is the fundamental response we are to have toward God. Everything we have comes from him. Better yet, in the Mass, He gives us everything we could ever want, *eternal life*. Catholic Cowboys fight for love... and we show it by fighting for Him in the Mass."

I was talking recently with Fr. Tom Ogg, a retired priest of our diocese. He grew up on a ranch north of Worland and his mom was raised on the same ranch. He recalls her saying how, growing up, she was only able to make it to Mass once every two months. Fr. Endres would come through Worland from Thermopolis only once a month. Only half the family could fit in their wagon. So mom and dad went into town to Mass with half the kids one month and the other half the next!

I share that, not to say it's fine to go to Mass only once every two months, but because it always helps me to put things in perspective. I was talking with a family from Worland who immigrated from Mexico many years ago. They were telling me how, growing up, cactus was their staple food and it was a super-special treat to get an egg for Christmas! Just because they only got an egg once a year doesn't mean that was enough. Just because Fr. Ogg's mom only made it to Mass as a kid once every two weeks doesn't mean that was enough. But the reality is, we play with the cards we're dealt and we strive to love and serve God with the circumstances and resources we have. If the fundamental orientation of our hearts is *truly* to love God with *all* our heart, soul, mind, and strength, He always takes care of the rest.



As Bishop Steven celebrates the 30th anniversary of his priestly ordination on Sunday, July 9, let us, pray in gratitude that God will shower him with many blessings from heaven and guide and protect him always as he faithfully serves the Lord in the vineyard.
