From Fr. Robert...

The parish feast day of our parish in Worland is this Saturday! Two days of adoration precede the Saturday Mass, picnic and festivities! Everyone from both parishes is welcome to attend!

As I'm preaching this weekend, St. Mary Magdalen is a model for the importance and power of the "spiritual combat." Luke 1:2 tells us: Accompanying [Jesus] were the Twelve and some women who had been cured of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary, called Magdalene, from whom seven demons had gone out..." It was her being liberated from the oppression of the enemy that led her to love and follow Jesus so ardently.

Demons are like bullies, who capitalize on our weaknesses and wounds and keep beating us down and preventing us from following God in freedom. Jesus came to liberate us from the power of evil, just as He did with St. Mary Magdalen. I believe that the evil one is especially attacking our families right now.
