Process of Discernment

Tomorrow will mark the 11th anniversary of my Ordination to the Diaconate. I was ordained six days after my thirty -fourth birthday at St. Mary's Cathedral in Cheyenne by, now Archbishop Paul D. Etienne.

For me, the discernment process began many years ago when I was a young altar server here at St. Mary Magdalen and Father Joseph Fraher was our Pastor. I remember vividly serving at Mass, looking at Father Fraher and thinking that he was doing something I could do someday. That began a process of asking God what I was to do in life.

Twenty-five years ago, in the Fall of 1998 I entered Conception Seminary College to discern a call to the priesthood. For two and one half years, through study and prayer, I discerned that call. I ultimately discerned that I was being called to glorify God through the married life. Then in late 2006 I began to hear a call from God about the diaconate.

In February 2007, I and about ninety other men went to Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church in Casper to hear about the diaconate. For the next five years, through a series of ups and downs, I discerned that God was calling me to the diaconate.

Each year on my anniversary I reflect on that ordination and the process of discernment.

A question that people often get asked or ask themselves is, "what do I (you) want to do when I (you) grow up?" A better question is to ask, "What does God want you to do?" The process of answering this question is what we call discernment.

Discernment is simply taking the time to prayerfully consider what God is calling you to do in your life. There are different stages of discernment, but ultimately, discernment requires prayer, study and patience. It can take time to hear what God is saying.

There are steps you can take right now to help discern God's call. The first thing to do is pray. Have a conversation with God. Speak to Him from the heart. Attend to the Sacraments, specifically Reconciliation and Eucharist as often as possible. Get good information on what it means to live a good Catholic marriage; what it means to be a priest, religious sister or brother. Take that information to prayer. Make sure to get good spiritual advice. A clear picture will begin to develop.

This picture will allow you to clearly see God's will for you in your life. Once you hear God's call or believe that you are to take certain steps, have courage and take those steps. When you hear God's call, take our Blessed Mother's advice, "Do whatever He tells you" (John 2:5).

"My hope is in Christ, who strengthens the weakest by his Divine help. I can do all in Him who strengthens me. His Power is infinite and if I lean on Him, it will be mine. His Wisdom is infinite and if I look to Him for counsel, I shall not be deceived. His Goodness is infinite and if my trust is stayed in Him, I shall not be abandoned.
