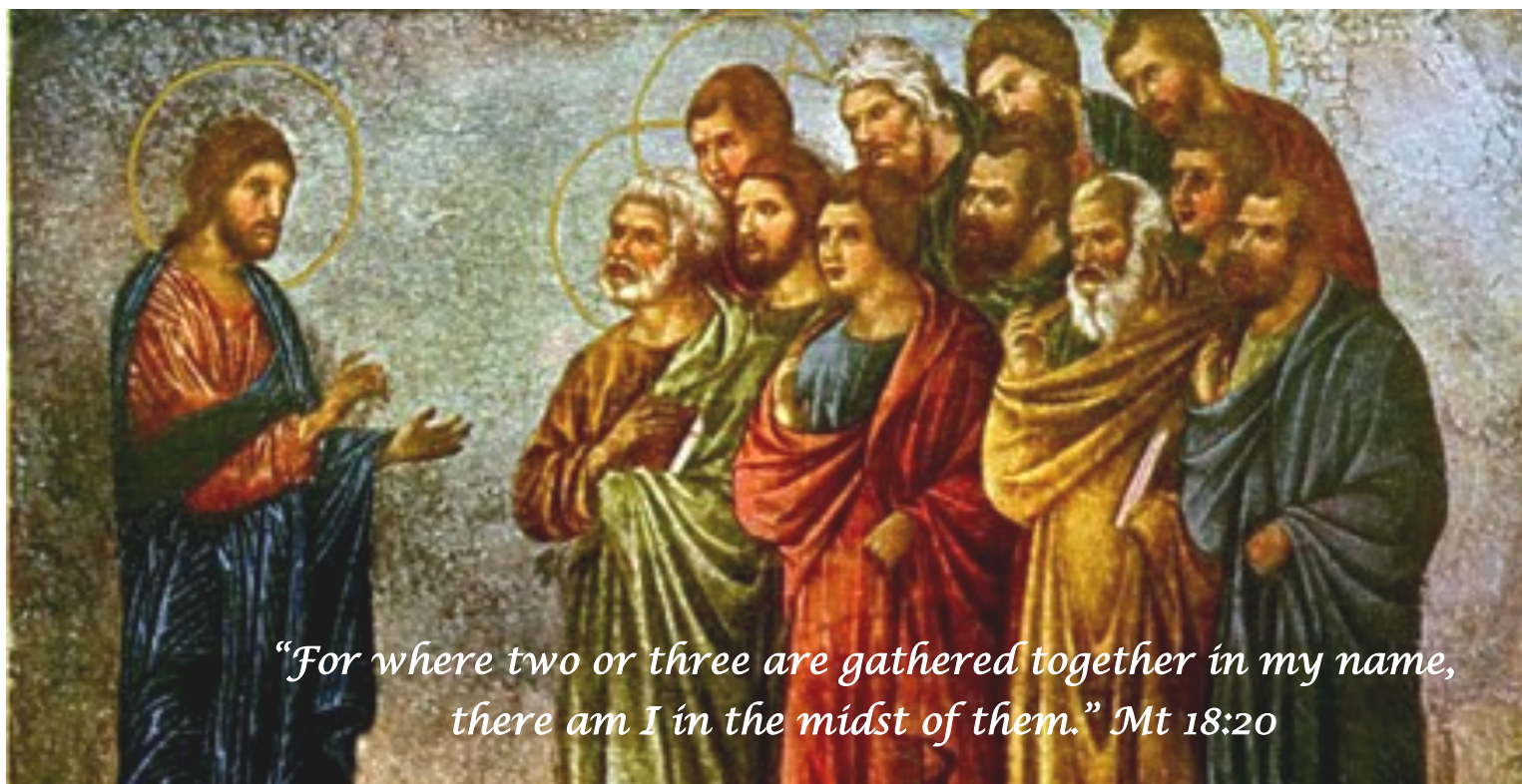

This Thursday, the 14th, is the Feast of the Triumph of the Holy Cross. I preached last weekend about how Jesus invites us into the mystery of the triumph of love over suffering, when he tells us, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me."

For us as Christians, the Holy Cross is the triumphant sign of victory, the splendor and glory of the love of Jesus for us. That's why St. Paul Could say, "But may I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world" (Gal 6:14).

As we contemplate the victory of Divine Love on the Cross this week, the following prayer to Jesus Crucified might inspire us to bear our own crosses with great love:

Look down upon me, good and gentle Jesus, While before Your face I humbly kneel And with burning soul, pray and beseech You, to fix deep in my heart, lively sentiments of faith, hope and charity, true contrition for my sins and a firm purpose of amendment, while I contemplate with great love and tender pity, Thy five most precious wounds, pondering over them within me, and calling to mind the words that David, your prophet, said of you, my Jesus, "They have pierced my hands and feet, They have numbered all my bones."

Miradme, ¡oh mi amado y buen Jesús!, postrado ante vuestra Santísima presencia; os ruego con el mayor fervor y compasión de que soy capaz imprimáis en mi corazón vivos sentimientos de fe, esperanza y caridad. Verdadero dolor de mis pecados, propósito firmísimo de jamás ofenderos. Mientras que yo, con todo el amor de que soy capaz voy considerando vuestra cinco llagas, comenzando por aquello que dijo de Vos, oh buen Jesús, el santo profeta David: ¡«Han taladrado mis manos y mis pies y se pueden contar todos mis huesos.»
