Teach me your ways, O Lord. Ps 25

Monday is the national Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. This, of course, is a cause which the Catholic Church holds near and dear. It transcends our political camps and is founded on the fact that God creates every human being in His image and likeness from the moment of conception.

The US Bishops, in their recently-revised guide for American Catholics on "Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship", declare the following: "The threat of abortion remains our preeminent priority because it directly attacks our most vulnerable and voiceless brothers and sisters and destroys more than a million lives per year in our country alone..."

In Wyoming, we still have progress to make on this front. Legislation to limit abortion is still held up in the courts, and a new abortion clinic in Casper has opened and is currently operating.

This issue is, of course, quite polarizing in our country, so it must be approached with an extra dose of compassion and love from the Catholic point of view. Here is a prayer composed by the US bishops for this upcoming day of prayer on Monday, which I would invite all of us to pray:

O Blessed Mother, you received the good news of the incarnation of Christ, your Son, with faith and trust. Grant your protection to all pregnant mothers facing difficulties. Guide us as we strive to make our parish communities places of welcome and assistance for mothers in need. Help us become instruments of God's love and compassion. Mary, Mother of the Church, graciously help us build a culture of life and a civilization of love, together with all people of good will, to the praise and glory of God, the Creator and lover of life. Amen.

El lunes es el Día nacional de Oración por la Protección Legal del Niño por Nacer. Es, por supuesto, una causa que la Iglesia Católica considera cercana y querida. Trasciende nuestros campos políticos y se funda en el hecho de que Dios crea a cada ser humano a su imagen y semejanza desde el momento de la concepción.

Los obispos estadounidenses, en su guía recientemente revisada para los católicos estadounidenses sobre "Formando la conciencia para ser ciudadanos fieles ", declaran lo siguiente: " La amenaza del aborto sigue siendo nuestra máxima prioridad, porque ataca directamente a la vida misma,4 porque tiene lugar dentro del santuario de la familia y por la cantidad de vidas destruidas. "

En Wyoming todavía tenemos mucho que hacer en este tema. La legislación para limitar el aborto todavía está detenida en los tribunales, y se ha abierto una nueva clínica de abortos en Casper, que actualmente está en funcionamiento.

Este tema es, por supuesto, bastante polarizante en nuestro país, por lo que debemos avanzar con una dosis extra de compasión y amor desde el punto de vista católico. La siguiente es una oración compuesta por los obispos de Estados Unidos para este día de oración del lunes, que me gustaría invitar a todos a orar:

Oh Madre Santa, recibiste la buena nueva de la encarnación de Cristo, tu Hijo, con fe y confianza. Concede tu protección a todas las embarazadas que enfrentan dificultades. Guíanos en nuestro esfuerzo por hacer de nuestras comunidades parroquiales lugares de acogida y asistencia para las madres necesitadas. Ayúdanos a convertirnos en instrumentos del amor y la compasión del Dios bondadoso. María, Madre de la Iglesia, ayúdanos a crear la cultura de la vida y la civilización de amor, junto con todas las personas de buena voluntad, para alabanza y gloria de Dios Creador, y amante de la vida. Amén.




