

From Fr. Robert. . .

This Friday is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as **"Candlemas"** because of the blessing of candles which occurs during Mass. The candles are part of this feast's strong connotation of **light** because of the fact that St. Simeon declared Jesus to be "a light for revelation to the Gentiles" (Lk 2:32) when He was presented in the temple.

Jesus declared in John 9:5, "While I am in the world, I am the light of the world." What do we do now that He is no longer in the world in the same way that He was when He walked the earth? He tells us, "You are the light of the world. A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and then put it under a bushel basket; it is set on a lampstand, where it gives light to all in the house. Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father" (Mt 5:14-16).

Part of our calling as Catholics is to foster the love/presence of God in our hearts so that we can let *His light shine* upon others. As St. John Henry Newman prayed, "Stay with me and then I shall begin to shine as You shine, so to shine as to be a light to others; **The light, O Jesus will be all from You; none of it will be mine; It will be you shining on others through me.**"

Let us earnestly strive to encounter the source of light, Jesus Christ, such that we might pray with St. Simeon, "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in sight of all the peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel" (Lk 2:29-32).

Este viernes es la Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor, también llamada "**Candelaria**" por la bendición de velas que hacemos durante la Misa. Las velas son parte de la fuerte connotación de **luz** de esta fiesta debido a que San Simeón declaró a Jesús. ser "luz para iluminar a los gentiles" (Lc 2,32) cuando fue presentado en el templo.

Jesús declaró en Juan 9:5: "Mientras estoy en el mundo, soy la luz del mundo". ¿Qué hacemos ahora que Él ya no está en el mundo de la misma manera que estaba cuando caminó sobre la tierra? Él nos dice: "Ustedes son la luz del mundo: ¿cómo se puede esconder una ciudad asentada sobre un monte? Nadie enciende una lámpara para taparla con un cajón; la ponen más bien sobre un candelero, y alumbra a todos los que están en la casa. Hagan, pues, que brille su luz ante los hombres; que vean estas buenas obras, y por ello den gloria al Padre de ustedes que está en los Cielos" (Mt 5,14-16).

Parte de nuestra vocación como católicos es fomentar el amor/presencia de Dios en nuestros corazones para que podamos dejar que Su luz brille sobre los demás. Como oró San John Henry Newman: "Quédate conmigo. Así podré convertirme en luz para los otros. **Esa luz, oh Jesús, vendrá toda de Ti; ni uno solo de sus rayos será mío.**"

Esforcémonos sinceramente por encontrar la fuente de luz, Jesucristo, para poder orar con San Simeón: "Ahora, Señor, ya puedes dejar que tu servidor muera en paz como le has dicho. Porque mis ojos han visto a tu salvador, que has preparado y ofreces a todos los pueblos, luz que se revelará a las naciones y gloria de tu pueblo, Israel" (Lc 2,29-32).


