The three-year national Eucharistic Revival ends this Spring. **Therefore, on June 22nd, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi**, we will be able to bear witness to our Faith by hosting a Eucharistic



Procession that will span six miles! The Catholic churches in our area have agreed to join us! The pilgrimage will begin at Icelandic State Park, and will conclude here at St Brigid. We will walk the paved bike path (so safe, and free of traffic). **The walk will begin at 1:00 pm. Each parish will be responsible for one mile,** with its priest carrying the Monstrance for that mile. However, persons can do more than one mile if they so choose. The priests

have agreed to walk the whole six miles! This is a great opportunity **for families to share their Faith by walking the mile together.** The priests who have already committed to participate are: Frs.
