

CELEBRATING THE SACRAMENTS

Baptism

Parents seeking Baptism for their child are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation class held the first Saturday of each month at 10am. See our website to register for class.

Parish Religious Education

Our Lady Star of the Sea's Parish Youth Catechesis Program provides religious education to children in grades PK through 12th, as well as sacramental preparation and programs for children and teens who need Baptism or are behind in the sacraments.

Become Catholic: RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is for those who have never been baptized, those baptized in another Christian faith tradition, those interested in joining the Catholic Church, and Catholics who were baptized but have not celebrated all of their Sacraments.

Matrimony

Couples seeking to be married in the Church are required to contact the parish office a minimum of six months prior to the desired wedding date to allow time for preparation. At least one of the engaged should be a registered and practicing member of the parish.

Anointing of the Sick

The Sacraments of the Sick is for spiritual comfort, strength and healing of the ill. If there is a need for the sacrament in your family or household, please contact the parish office as soon as possible.

DEALING WITH MYTHS.

MYTH: If you express intense feelings, you're losing control.

The TRUTH is that expressing your feelings is not a loss of control but is very normal and healthy. You may not want to burden family and friends with your feelings. You may sense that they become uncomfortable and don't know what to say to you when you talk about it.

A Stephen Minister can help. They are trained to listen to you without judging you. They maintain everything that is discussed and even your identity is confidential. They will help you sort through your thoughts and feelings and not tell you what to do as they accompany along on your journey through grief.


