

CELEBRATING THE SACRAMENTS

Baptism

Parents seeking Baptism for their child are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation class held the first Saturday of each month at 10am. See our website to register for class.

Parish Religious Education

Our Lady Star of the Sea's Parish Youth Catechesis Program provides religious education to children in grades PK through 12th, as well as sacramental preparation and programs for children and teens who need Baptism or are behind in the sacraments.

Become Catholic: RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is for those who have never been baptized, those baptized in another Christian faith tradition, those interested in joining the Catholic Church, and Catholics who were baptized but have not celebrated all of their Sacraments.

Matrimony

Couples seeking to be married in the Church are required to contact the parish office a minimum of six months prior to the desired wedding date to allow time for preparation. At least one of the engaged should be a registered and practicing member of the parish.

Anointing of the Sick

The Sacraments of the Sick is for spiritual comfort, strength and healing of the ill. If there is a need for the sacrament in your family or household, please contact the parish office as soon as possible.

Classes are held weekly from 9:15-10:45 for PreK through Confirmation students beginning September 7th.

A 2 year minimum of religious instruction at OLSS is required prior to the reception of First Confession, First Holy Communion and Confirmation.
