



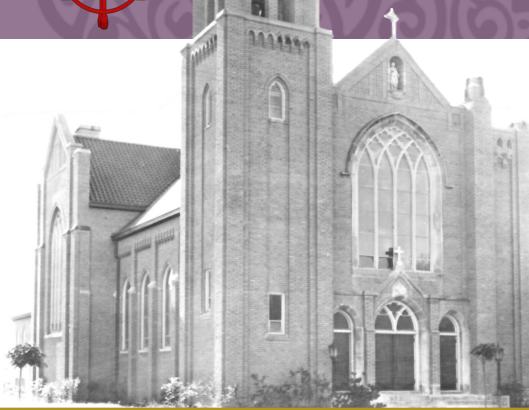

## Propers for Sunday

10:00 AM

**Introit:** Give me justice, O God, and plead my cause against a nation that is faithless. From the deceitful and cunning rescue me, for You, O God, are my strength. Send forth Your light and Your truth; these have led me and brought me to Your holy mountain and to Your dwelling place.

**Gradual:** Rescue me, Lord, from my enemies; teach me to do Your will. O Lord, You who save me from the wrath of the nations, You shall cause me to triumph over my assailants; You will save me from the man of evil.

**Tract:** Often have they fought against me from my youth. Let Israel now say: Often have they fought against me from my youth. Yet, they have not prevailed against me: my back has become an anvil for the hammering of sinners. They have long oppressed me with their iniquities. But the Lord of justice will break the neck of sinners.

**Offertory:** I will praise You, O Lord, with my whole heart; deal bountifully with Your servant, that I may live and observe Your word; revive me according to Your word.

**Communion:** When the Lord saw the sisters of Lazarus in tears near the tomb, he wept in the presence of the Jews and cried: "Lazarus, come forth." And he came out, hands and feet bound, the man who had been dead for four days.
