Our Lady of Fatima Rosary Procession

Saturday, August 19th | 6:00 PM

Here at St. Peter's, we hold a Rosary Procession each month from May through October, to honor the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima to three shepherd children.

Typically held on the 13th of each month, August happens to be the one month where the apparition did not take place on the 13th. As August 13, 1917 approached, Lucia, Francisco, & Jacinta, the 3 shepherd children, were kidnapped and interrogated about the apparitions. It was not until the 15th when they were finally released. On August 19th the Virgin Mother finally appeared to the children.

In honor of this 4th apparition, we will hold our Rosary Procession on Saturday, August 19th. Join us at 6:00 PM, following the Saturday evening Mass, for a talk followed by the procession.
