# **Observing the Ember Days**

The Ember Days are ancient days of fasting and penance in the Church which took place on a Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday, typically around the beginning of each season. The first record of the Ember Days is attributed to Pope Saint Callistus I, in 222 AD.

These 3-days at the beginning of a season serve as an opportunity to start out observances on the right foot.

We ask you to join the Canons Regular of St. John Cantius in observing the upcoming Ember days, next week, with fasting and abstinence. We also ask you to consider joining us for Mass as well as the Divine Office on these 3-days.

Those days are Wednesday, September 20th, Friday, September 22nd, as well as Saturday, September 23rd.

# New Floors Throughout St. Peter's Church

Over the last few years, St. Peter's has focused a great deal on restoring our church to her true beauty.

We kicked off this series of restoration projects by first addressing the leaking windows before moving on to repairing the damaged plaster throughout the church. This gave way to our largest project to date, the painting of our church interior. With painting now complete, we are turning our sites lower - to the floors.

Meetings with contractors are underway and we have begun looking at materials. We are excitedly anticipating the work to begin very soon.

We have begun to raise the funds to cover the restoration of our floors, and so far we have raised \$3,842.00.
