ANGELS UNAWARES

The second life-sized bronze cast of the 20 foot sculpture in St. Peter's Square will be on display at the Cathedral Saturday, March 7 through mid-April. This is its first stop in the United States and will be its only visit to California as it tours the country.

This powerful and moving sculpture depicts a group of migrants and refugees from different cultural and racial backgrounds and from diverse historic periods of time. They stand together, shoulder to shoulder, huddled on a raft. Within this diverse crowd of people, angel wings emerge from the center, suggesting the presence of the sacred among them. The inspiration behind the work is taken from the biblical passage: "Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares." (Hebrew 13-2)

In the state of California, anyone who has engaged in sexual misconduct with a child under the age of 16 is not allowed to work directly with minors, or to be unaccompanied with minors. This includes volunteer and employee positions. This law helps to create safe environments for our children in our schools and churches.
