40 Days for Life Results

During this Fall 40 Days for Life, at least 487 babies have been saved from abortion, including five babies in Sacramento, where parishioners from throughout the area have been praying daily outside Planned Parenthood. One young mom in particular, homeless and nine weeks pregnant, was headed in to have an abortion, but changed her mind because she was offered the help she needed. Even though the Fall 40 Days ended this week, prayers and offers of help will continue at this abortion clinic. 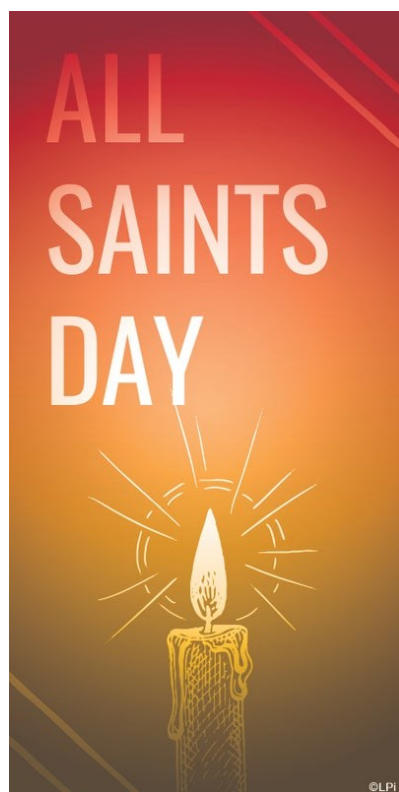
