



Our Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Greetings to you in Christ! We hope that this Lenten season has been meaningful for you on your faith journey.

And now we enter upon the most holy time of the year; we now hold before ourselves the most central events in our Lord's life, his Paschal Mystery, the mysteries of our salvation: his passion, death on the cross, and glorious resurrection.

As God brought to completion His plan for our salvation, our Lord Jesus literally walked the way of the cross. Like the Palm Sunday crowd, it is so easy to cheer on the Messiah at His triumphal entry to the Holy City of Jerusalem. That costs us very little. But it is a very different thing to stand with Him when He is betrayed and is falsely accused before the Sanhedrin and again before Pilate, while He is mocked and beaten by the Roman soldiers, while He bears the judgment of all mankind upon the cross.

Dying with Christ is precisely what every Christian is called to do. Yet as St. Paul encourages us, "For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his." (Rom 6:5) We know that the cross on Good Friday did not have the last word; Easter Sunday does; the empty tomb does; Jesus' resurrection does.

The fact that Jesus is risen from the dead, that he was and is victorious over death and sin, is the reason we celebrate. It's the fact that gives us joy despite our circumstances and through whatever we may face. It's reason we believe, hope, and love. What happened on that first Easter morning still brings us joy and it still changes lives today.

As we continue walking with our Lord and the whole Church these last days of our Lenten Journey, I would like to invite you to our Holy Week and Easter celebrations. With gratitude for all you are and all you do to grace St. Joseph's Parish and the Missions of St. Boniface and St. Daniel, we the clergy and the parish staff hold you in our hearts and in our prayers, asking God to bless you and your loved ones and friends, with the Easter joy.


Let us together rejoice and sing joyfully as we celebrate the Feast of our salvation.

Muy Queridos Feligreses y Amigos,

¡Saludos en Cristo nuestro Señor! Esperamos que este tiempo de Cuaresma haya sido un tiempo propicio de oración y conversión, y de gran beneficio espiritual en su camino de fe.

Ahora, entramos en el tiempo más sagrado de todo el año litúrgico; celebraremos los eventos centrales de la vida de nuestro Señor, su Misterio Pascual, los mismos misterios de nuestra salvación: su pasión, muerte en la cruz y resurrección gloriosa.

Para completar el plan de nuestra salvación, Jesús nuestro Señor libremente escogió el camino de la cruz. Y como la multitud del Domingo de Ramos, es fácil seguir y animar al Mesías en su entrada triunfal a la ciudad santa de Jerusalén. Pero el verdadero reto se encuentra en seguirlo, en estar con Él cuando es traicionado y acusado falsamente ante el Sanedrín y luego ante Pilato, cuando los soldados romanos se burlan de Él y lo golpean, cuando está clavado en la cruz por toda la humanidad. Porque morir con Cristo, es precisamente lo que todo cristiano está llamado a hacer. Sin embargo, como nos recuerda San Pablo, sabemos que “si hemos sido injertados en Él por una muerte semejante a la suya, también lo estaremos por una resurrección semejante.” (Rom 6:5) Por tanto, sabemos que la cruz del viernes santo no tiene la última palabra; el domingo de Pascua, sí; la tumba vacía, sí; la resurrección de Jesús, sí.

El hecho admirable de que Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos, que victoriósamente ha vencido al pecado y a la muerte, es la razón por la que celebramos. Este hecho glorioso es lo que nos da alegría a pesar de nuestras circunstancias y de todo lo adverso a lo que nos podamos enfrentar. Esta es la razón de nuestra fe, esperanza y caridad. Lo que sucedió en esa primera mañana de Pascua nos sigue trayendo alegría y sigue hasta el día hoy poderosamente cambiando vidas.

Así pues, al continuar caminando con Jesús nuestro Señor y toda la Iglesia en estos últimos días de preparación cuaresmal, nos gustaría invitarlos a nuestras celebraciones de Semana Santa y Pascua. El horario se encuentra adjunto a esta carta o también pueden visitar nuestra página de internet o llamar a la oficina parroquial para obtener más información.

Con gratitud por el gran regalo que son cada uno de ustedes y por todo lo que hacen por nuestra Parroquia de San José y las Misiones de San Bonifacio y San Daniel, nosotros, el clero y el personal de la parroquia, rezamos pidiendo a Dios todopoderoso que los bendiga abundantemente, a ustedes a todos sus familiares y amigos.
