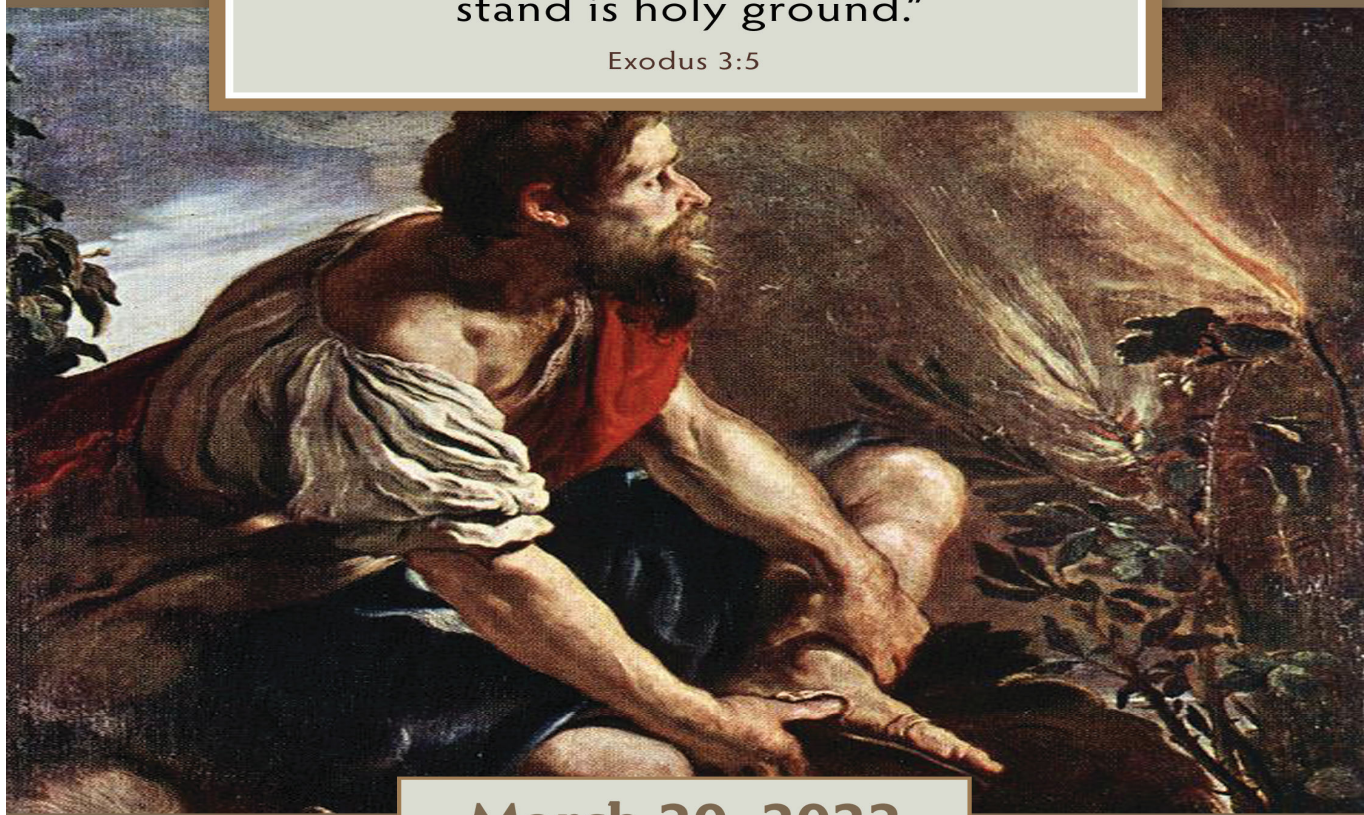

Pope Francis continues to open up the richness of Synodality:

“Celebrating a Synod means walking on the same road, together.

Encountering faces, meeting eyes, sharing each individual’s history, represents the closeness that Jesus embodies, and no question annoys or disturbs him, because he’s open to encounter. Let us ask: in the Church are we good at listening? Do we allow people to express themselves, to walk in faith even though they have had difficulties in life, and to be part of the life of the parish community without being hindered, rejected or judged?”

As the Gospel today tells us to cultivate and fertilize the Fig tree, how are we cultivating our parish community.

Two final aspects of our Synod journey, fostering synodality here at St. Brendan Parish:

SHARING RESPONSIBILITY FOR OUR MISSION

Synodality is at the service of the mission of the Church, in which all members are called to participate.

Since we are all “missionary disciples of Jesus” how is each member of our parish called to participate in the mission of the Church?

What areas of mission are we neglecting at St. Brendan?

Is our sense of mission obvious, vibrant and welcome? How can we intensify our mission?

Do people living in our neighborhood immediately recognize St. Brendan as a welcoming and healing community of believers? If not, how can we move in that direction?

FORMING OURSELVES IN SYNODALITY

Synodality entails receptivity to change, formation, and on-going learning. How does our parish community form people to be more capable of “walking together,” listening to one another, participating in mission, and engaging in dialogue?

Synodality requires perseverance and patience, but it also enables mutual understanding.

To what extent do diverse parishioners in our parish come together for dialogue?

What are the places and means of dialogue within our parish that we want to implement?

How are divergencies of vision, or conflicts and difficulties addressed?

What particular issues in the Church and in our parish do we need to pay more attention to, such as young adults? High School youth? Our older parishioners? Our School parents? Our low-income families?

How can we “walk together” as a parish community?

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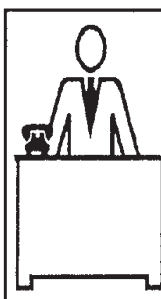

ST. BRENDAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY 2021-2022 **SCHOOL STUDENT NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY**

While the school does not discriminate against students with special needs, a full range of services may not always be available to them. Decisions concerning the admission and continued enrollment of a student in the school are based upon the student's emotional, academic, and physical abilities and the resources available to the school in meeting the student's needs.
