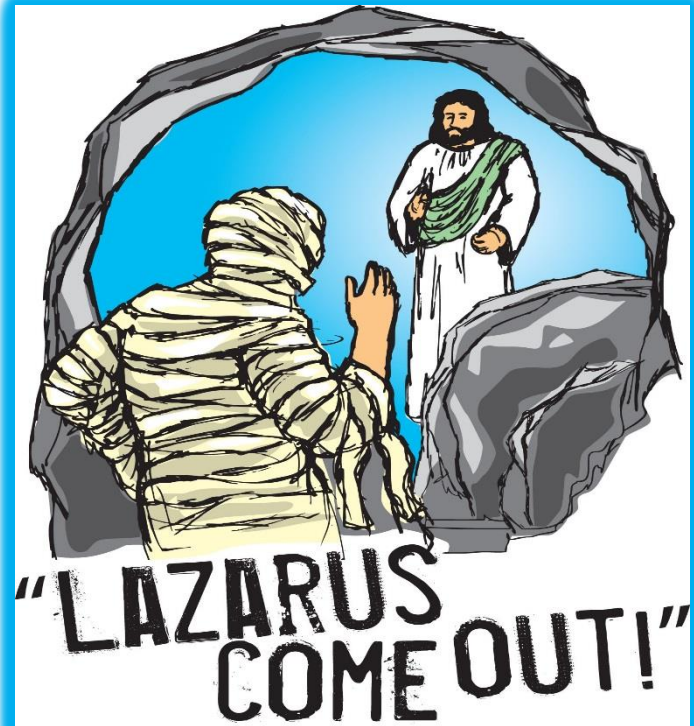

Letter from Fr. Jeff

Dear Parishioners,

During these difficult days Our Lord remains close to us. Even though public Masses have been suspended and you may not be able to receive Holy Communion for some time, Our Lord remains close to us. He remains present to us.

Jesus said, "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, I am present." So, in your families when you come together to pray, Jesus is present. He is also present in your heart through His grace which comes to us through the Holy Spirit. All you have to do is pray and He is there. Jesus also remains present and close to us in the Blessed Sacrament whether exposed on the altar or in the tabernacle. 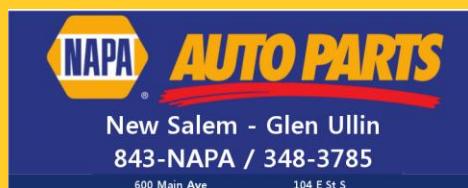
