





In a few short weeks we will begin a new year of religious education and formation for our youth. We would ask that all parents take the time to register their children as soon as possible. You can register online by means of our Area Faith Community Website or by coming into the office. If we could have all of our young people registered by September 1st it would be of great assistance to Beth. She can then have all the class lists prepared, teachers assigned, and rooms designated.

We are looking forward to a great year of spiritual growth and the strengthening of the faith in our youth and their families.

WE are particularly excited this year for we are beginning a new curriculum, Word of Life, (Augustine Institute) that promises to be very good for our students and their parents. I believe that it is a big step in the right direction. It is inviting to our students as well as maximum parental involvement and accountability. Only K through 5 of the curriculum is finished and is able to be used. So, we will be using this new Curriculum in grades K – 5 with the expectation that grades 6-8 will be completed for next year and a High School curriculum in the near future. It is our fondest hope that we will have all our young people from K-12th grade fully involved in religious formation as well as many adults. All of us need to continually strive for greater knowledge of the Lord Jesus, His holy Church and a greater desire to give Him worship and reach out to serve him in our neighbor.

Adult Formation

We continue to look forward to offering some adult formation in the Fall. There are a number of programs that are of 6-8 weeks duration that would help all of us deepen our knowledge and love of the Lord Jesus and the Church.

Hopefully in the next few weeks all parishioners at St. Mary's will be receiving a letter inviting all to give generously to the Fall Collection. This is an important way to help build up our Parish community. it is especially important this year because we have several major maintenance items before us. It would be good for the parish to look forward to initiating a day of community enhancements thought fun things, meal and games for the youth and an opportunity to just spend time with each other.
