

### The Stations of the Cross

We continue to get positive comments about the Stations of the Cross from St. Thomas's Oratory at Jessenland which are now hanging in the Church of St. Mary. They blend in beautifully with the décor of St. Mary's.

They truly enrich our Church and highlight this meaningful devotion. We are so grateful to God that we have been able to use them in St. Mary's Church. It is also a consolation to the many good people from Jessenland, who are members here who are finding comfort in knowing that something that was of value to their faith lives will still enrich it here at St. Mary's.

The response to help paying for their refurbishing has been great. We now have donors for ten and possibly eleven of the stations. Thanks to those who have made a commitment. Please call the parish office to make your commitment to pay for the refurbishing of one or more of them.

If we get sufficient donors, we will be able to sign the contract and have the refurbishing begin around Christmas and possibly have them completed by Lent, 2024. The artist and restorer will take two or three at a time to his shop, when they are refurbished, he will return them and proceed with the next two or three until they are finished.

The cost to refurbish is \$850.00.




