**The month of November is traditionally dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory. As we know, the souls in purgatory depend on our prayers and sacrifices. Prayer for the souls in Purgatory is a requirement of Christian charity, and it helps us to call to mind our own mortality.**

**Saying the De Profundis (Psalm 130):** The De Profundis is a traditional Catholic prayer, also known as Psalm 130, which begins with the words "Out of the depths, I cry to you, O Lord." It's often prayed for the souls in Purgatory, asking God to have mercy on them and lead them into His presence.

**Passing a cemetery:** As you drive or walk past a cemetery, pray for those buried there. This prayer is often prayed for the souls in purgatory: *Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen*

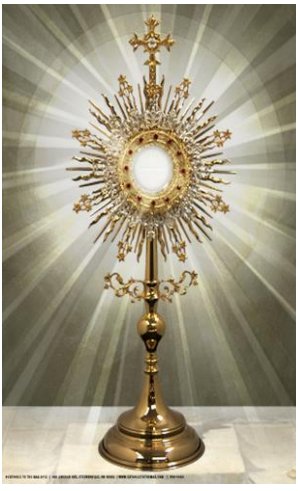
