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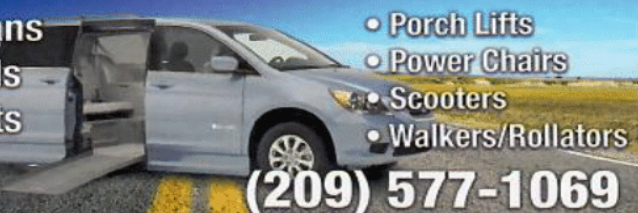

Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

First Reading

With their patience worn out by the journey, the people complained against God and Moses, "Why have you brought us up from Egypt to die in this desert, where there is no food or water? We are disgusted with this wretched food!" In punishment the LORD sent among the people saraph serpents, which bit the people so that many of them died. Then the people came to Moses and said, "We have sinned in complaining against the LORD and you. Pray the LORD to take the serpents from us." So Moses prayed for the people, and the LORD said to Moses, "Make a saraph and mount it on a pole, and if any who have been bitten look at it, they will live." Gospel

John 3:13-17

Jesus said to Nicodemus: "No one has gone up to heaven except the one who has come down from heaven, the Son of Man. And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. ***The Gospel of the Lord.***

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Gospel Mediation

One of my favorite movies is the 1991 comedy What About Bob? Bill Murray plays a troubled, paranoid hypochondriac named Bob Wiley who innocently but annoyingly hounds Dr. Leo Marvin, played by Richard Dreyfuss. Bob is paralyzed by his fear of, well, everything, and is convinced the psychologist can heal him. But Dr. Marvin's failed attempts to heal Bob end up driving the doctor to attempt to murder Bob. He fails. The surprise is that, having faced death head on, Bob is suddenly healed. He attributes his healing to Dr Marvin for break-through "death therapy." In facing the cause of his deepest illness and dysfunction, Bob is healed. Underneath this light-hearted comedy is a dead-serious resonance with this week's feast: the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. Christ is lifted up on the cross to force us to face the truth of sin and death. In that reckoning we find healing. Like Moses' snake on a pole, the cross says: this is what is causing your sickness – rebellion, disobedience, sin. Look at it! Don't run from it. Now seeing it exposed, we see life. We see our physician mercifully healing us. In this sense, we are all like Bob Wiley. The "death therapy" of the cross is our only hope for healing. This week I invite you to "exalt the cross." If you don't have one in your house, get one. Use it for prayer. Gaze on it frequently. It teaches us to not be afraid. It heals us. — Father John Muir ©LPi

Mensaje de Padre Juan

Queridos hermanos, en mis 4 meses de misión en tierra extranjera, he tenido muchas experiencias favorables y raras en un país donde el idioma, la ropa, la comida y costumbres son totalmente diferentes a nuestro continente. Aquí el matrimonio no es un vínculo de amor, es solamente un contrato (acuerdo) entre dos personas en donde el amor puede o no existir. Por eso, mi primera experiencia fue de que me propusieran matrimonio dos mujeres. Algo raro y chistoso pero sucede en este país porque es la forma de que un musulmán pueda salir de este lugar para ir al extranjero. Quieres comprar algo y no te entienden, puedes usar señas o mímica. No cabe duda de que en cualquier forma te comunicas con el otro. La gente acostumbra ser amable con los extranjeros, el motivo es el comercio. Pero hasta la fecha no me he encontrado alguien que me haya faltado el respeto. Por último (y en lo que me quiero enfocar) quisiera compartirles la vivencia de la fe. Aquí en algunas iglesias son 3 ó 5 personas a lo mucho en las misas dominicales. No hay procesiones, rezos públicos ni dinámicas en cuestión al cristianismo que se puedan realizar por la calle. Todo es dentro del templo y con muy pocos fieles. Varias ocasiones me tocó celebrar misa con 1 sola persona, esto es triste. Quiero invitarlos a que reflexionen sobre el valor de celebrar la fe en comunidad. Allí en USA o México poco se piensa de eso porque asisten muchos. Pero aquí la cosa es distinta y sumando la probabilidad de que algún radical quiera hacer daño a alguna Iglesia (que son pocas y contadas). Estos 4 meses me han ayudado a ser agradecido con Dios por darme una familia tan bella y grande que es el cristianismo. Cuando estén en misa, den gracias que son muchos y no caben. Den gracias porque tienen sacerdotes (aquí son pocos y se recorren distancias largas para celebrar misa a 5 cristianos o alguna comunidad de religiosas). Y sobre todo den gracias de que pueden elegir ser cristianos y vivir libremente la fe, porque los nativos no pueden hacerlo y esta penado por ley. Habrá mas cosas que contar, pero será en otro momento. Los llevo en mi corazón (como se los prometí en las misas) y estarán siempre en mis oraciones. Fraternalmente Fray Michel Alonso (Padre Juan). Baptism: For kids under 7 years old
Arrangements are to be made in advance with the coordinator.

Faith Formation
For school age children (1st grade or higher) this is a three year preparation process.

Matrimony:
Bride and groom must begin preparation with a priest at least six months prior to intended date of marriage.
RCIA: (*Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults*)
For school children 7 years of age, as well as adults who have not been baptized. This process provides the opportunity become a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church.

Bautismo: Para niños menores de 7 años
Arreglos deben hacerse por adelantado con la coordinadora.

Formación de Fe
Para niños en edad escolar (1^{er} grado o mayor) esta es una preparación de tres años.

Matrimonio:
Novia y novio deben empezar la preparación con un sacerdote por lo menos seis meses antes de la fecha en que planean casarse.
RICA: (*Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos*)
Para niños de 7 años, así como adultos que no han sido bautizados. Este proceso brinda la oportunidad de convertirse en un cristiano católico completamente iniciado.
