WITH THE HELP OF SAINT CECILIA PASTORAL REFLECTIONS

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Angelus is the Latin word for "angel," and commonly refers to the prayer we traditionally pray at noontime and 6:00pm every day and by which we meditate on the Annunciation (cf. Luke 1:26–38). As you know, the prayer begins with the word "Angel":

 \mathring{V} . Behold the handmaid of the Lord. \mathring{R} . Be it done unto me according to thy word.

Hail Mary, full of grace; the Lord is with thee...

V. And the Word was made flesh. R. And dwelt among us.

Hail Mary, full of grace; the Lord is with thee...

V. Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

R.That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray,

Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that, we, to whom the Incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ our Lord. R. Amen.

Since its origin, sometime in the eleventh century, the reciting of the Angelus has always been connected to the ringing of the "Angelus Bell" at noontime and 6:00pm. This week we have restored the ringing of the Angelus at noontime and 6:00pm in order, in the words of Saint Benedict's Rule, to 'listen and attend with the ear of our hearts.' The Angelus bell consists of three sets of three bells, separated by brief pause (a total of nine strokes). This is followed by an extended pealing of all the bells. The number of bells seem to have originated from the ancient practice of saying one "Hail Mary" on each of the three bell sets, with an "Our Father" in between.

Whatever you pray at noontime and 6:00pm, please stop whenever you hear the Angelus Bells and remember the voice of the Angel Gabriel, who announced our salvation to the Mother of God! In the Lord,
