As we prepare to begin another Lent, the Lord invites us to enter more deeply into his Paschal love for us. May we draw ever closer to his Cross in the coming forty days!

In order to help us do that, we are adding an extra Mass on Wednesday afternoon at 4pm. Confessions are moving from Wednesday to after the 6:00pm Mass on Thursday. Stations are back on Fridays at 6:00pm.

Our Canned Food Drive and Operation Rice Bowl will, once again, provide us a chance to share with those who are in need. Likewise, the Second Collection this weekend for the terrible earthquake victims in Syria and Turkey is a chance for us to work a bit more on our charity.

Fasting is also an important part of Lent, and I am very grateful to everyone who is making the Wednesday night Lenten Suppers possible. I will see you there!

Monsignor Francis Kelly, a wonderful teacher, will be presenting a three week series on his wonderful book, Discovering Christ: An Inquiry and Meditation, and I will be bringing back my Introduction to the Liturgy, which was so popular last year.

The Leominster Catholic Mission will begin on Wednesday, March 1<sup>st</sup> at Our Lady of the Lake and continue at each of the Leominster parishes on the following Wednesdays, including March 22<sup>nd</sup> here at Saint Cecilia's for a Penance Service. The theme of this year's mission will be Eucharistic Revival, and we will be able to hear reflections by five different priests on various aspects of that theme.

Of course, Lent is always a great time to get to daily Mass and go to Confession, so in this week's bulletin we have a Mass and Confession Finder, to make it easier for you.

Lots of other things happening these days, as well. I am delighted to announce that Bishop McManus signed a contract with the Spanish Cultural Center for the rental of some of our classrooms on the top floor of the Parish Center for a wonderful after-school program (it even includes a robot-lab!). Our parish will realize close to \$5,000 a month from the lease with these wonderful people, and they will also pay 50% of the Hall's utilities. We are blessed!

This week is so busy we are running out of room in the bulletin! A Blessed Lent to you!





# THE EARTHQUAKE

## IN TURKEY AND SYRIA



Bishop McManus has asked that a second collection be taken up this weekend to help those in Syria and Turkey who have been devastated by the worst earthquake in over a century. More than 35,000 people have died as of this writing.

You can drop your donation into the second collection today or drop it off at the rectory at your convenience. Checks should be made payable to Saint Cecilia Parish, with the memo "Earthquake Relief." We will then forward your donation to the Diocese, who will forward the donations of all the parishes to Catholic Relief Services (CRS) and the Catholic Near East Welfare Association who are best equipped to oversee the needed emergency humanitarian relief.

Finally, in the words of our Holy Father, "Let us pray together so that these our brothers and sisters can go forth in the face of this tragedy, and let us ask Our Lady to protect them."


