WITH THE HELP OF SAINT CECILIA PASTORAL REFLECTIONS

Dear brothers and sisters,

Father Paul and I were thrilled to hear that Bishop McManus has chosen Deacon Bob and Irene Connor as the recipients of the Mother Theresa Pro-Life Award this year. Their lives have been a testament to the Gospel of Life, as their children, the people at First Concern Pregnancy Resource Center and the mother and families whom they have supported throughout the years would testify. The award will be presented at Bishop McManus' Mass at the Cathedral this coming Friday at 10am for the Feast of the Annunciation. We will be there, and we hope you will be too.

This week, the engineers are scheduled to complete the last of their water testing, a prelude to the definitive repair of the gutters and roofs. That means that we will begin the restoration of the interior of our beloved Church sometime in July or August. For months we have been consulting with Rohn Design and Assosciates, those responsible for the original renovations in the 1980's. Included in this week's bulletin are two pages of the preliminary renderings for plastering and painting the interior, as well as several possible updates, including the restoration of the stone sanctuary floor, a new Blessed Sacrament Chapel in the choir, and handicapped access to the sanctuary/chapel level. A more detailed explanation of the color scheme and other enhancements to the Church can be found in a video on our Parish Facebook page.

Please know that these are all preliminary ideas and very much a work in progress. Your advice at every stage will be deeply appreciated.

While final numbers are not in on any of this, it is my intention to embark on any stage of the project only when the necessary funds are in hand. We are committed to painting and plastering and have approximately \$900,000 insurance money on hand. Anything else which we add to this will only be in response to your memorial gifts.


Similarly, the final numbers on the gutter and roof repair are still not in, awaiting the final report from the engineers. While the Diocese has generously provided us with a line of credit, it is my hope to secure the building from any future leaks without having to borrow any money. More on that to come!

Thanks for your patience with all of this! You know what it is like to paint the kitchen. Imagine all the moving parts in restoring the most magnificent Church in Worcester County! (Yes, I am prejudiced).

Most of all, I ask for your prayers, as we take the important step of securing the future for Saint Cecilia Church. We stand on the shoulders of giants. Through their prayers and yours, we sill make it so!




FOR A POSSIBLE TOMORROW

The following preliminary renderings describe possible color schemes and other enhancements for the restoration of Saint Cecilia Church. They were produced by Rohn Design and Associates, the same major design firm which had accomplished the last last restoration, nearly fifty years ago. The plans include plastering, painting, introduction of stars to the ceiling, marbellization to the columns and painting panels in the clerestory, as well as a restored stone floor, new and expanded Blessed Sacrament Chapel and a Testor over the altar, highlighting the Charpentier crucifix, as well as handicapped access to the sanctuary/ chapel level. 


