## WITH THE HELP OF SAINT CECILIA PASTORAL REFLECTIONS

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today we begin Holy Week, the holiest of all weeks of the year. I strongly encourage you to join us for the liturgies of the **Sacred Paschal Triduum** on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday as we celebrate the saving Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord.

I also encourage you to join Bishop McManus and all of the priests of our Diocese at the **Chrism Mass** at Saint Paul's Cathedral on Tuesday morning, at 10:30 A.M. The Chrism Mass gathers the diocesan family to celebrate the unity of all persons who have been anointed with Holy Chrism at Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Orders.

Bishop McManus blesses the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens and consecrates the Holy Chrism which will be used in sacramental rites throughout the coming year. Also during the Chrism Mass, the priests of the Diocese renew their Priestly Promises. Those priests who are celebrating notable anniversaries of priestly ordination and service to the Church in Worcester are also recognized.

You will notice that several pages of the Bulletin this week serve as a Music program for Holy Week. Please remember to either save this Bulletin or pick up a new one when you join us for these sacred rites this week.

Finally, I remind you of the importance of prayer during this Holy Week. Stop in the Church to say a little prayer before the Crucifix or to wait a while with the Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament. Perhaps stop into the chapel to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy or walk the Stations of the Cross. Meditate with Saint Cecilia on her participation in the Passion of the Lord or just sit quietly and let the light streaming through the stained glass windows remind you of the love which God bears for you and with which he embraces you this week in our commemoration of his saving Sacrifice upon the Altar of the Cross.


Over 250 people took part in the city-wide Penance Service on March 22<sup>nd</sup>, with seven priests hearing confessions.





#### FAITH FACTS

The Gospel Reading.

Crucifixion was the method used by the Romans to execute people. Often, the vertical part of the cross stayed in the



ground. The prisoner carried the cross-beam to the place of execution. He might or might not be tied to the beam. At the place of execution he was nailed to cross-beam and the beam was slotted onto the upright. Then the victim's feet were nailed to the upright. In Jesus' case, a notice was fixed to the cross.

Crucifixion was a horrible and agonizing way in which to die.


