Dear brothers and sisters,

Last week the boys and girls who appear on the cover of this week's bulletin received their First Holy Communion.

They had been watching all the other people go to receive Jesus for many years. But last week Jesus came to live inside of them in a very special way.

You know the story. How on the night before he died for us, Jesus took bread and gave to his disciples saying "take this, all of you, for this is my body, which will be given up for you." And every time we receive Jesus in that little piece of bread we remember his love for us, how much he wants to forgive us and how he came to save us that we might live with him forever in heaven.

Our recently deceased Pope emeritus, Benedict XVI, once spoke of the day of his First Holy Communion. He spoke of First Communion as the beginning of a "lifelong friendship with Jesus." From that moment, he said, "the Lord has always taken me by the hand, guided me even in difficult situations."


"So on that day I was really filled with great joy, because Jesus came to me and I realized that a new stage in my life was beginning, I was 9 years old, and that it was henceforth important to stay faithful to that encounter, to that communion. I promised the Lord as best I could: "I always want to stay with you", and I prayed to him, "but above all, stay with me". So I went on living my life like that; thanks be to God, the Lord has always taken me by the hand and guided me, even in difficult situations." On our part, the Pope said, we must be willing to say every day: "Jesus, I am yours. I will follow you in my life, I never want to lose this friendship, this communion with you."

I made my first communion sixty-one years ago, and I can still remember how good it felt when I received Jesus for the firs time. And do you know why I felt so good? Because I knew that God was always watching me and always loving me and always looking out for me. And now he loved me so much that he was coming to live in my heart. And my whole life is just trying to find out how I can love him too.

What a wonderful day last Sunday was for these children, and for us. A wonderful day, when God gave them the gift of his love.





A MASS FOR HEALING AT SAINT CECILIA'S CHURCH


THIS SATURDAY, MAY 20th, the 9:00am Mass will be celebrated for the intentions of everyone who is sick. After the Mass, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be given to those who are elderly or who have a serious illness.

What is the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick?

When the priest anoints the sick person with the Oil of the Sick blessed by the Bishop at the Chrism Mass, he prays that "through this holy anointing, may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord, who frees you from your sins, save you and raise you up." The Sacrament unites us to Christ's Passion, strengthens us to endure suffering, forgives our sins, restores our health if it's conducive for our salvation, and prepares us to enter eternal life.

Who can be anointed?

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is for any Baptized Catholic who is suffering from a grave illness which could, even remotely, end in death. It is not intended for those with a cold or a mild illness. Those who are elderly, by definition, may always be anointed.


