



Work will begin during the coming weeks on the gutters and lower roofs and I will share the full report with you after meeting with the Diocesan Building Commission. The analysis is so thorough, that they have recommended a fourteen year plan to bring Saint Cecilia's to exterior perfection.

Speaking of perfection, Bishop McManus has approved our plans for the interior restorations and those will be announced shortly, as well. We will have a dedicated website with an introductory video and Memorial Brochures in all the Bulletins. Stay tuned!

I've also been speaking with the Holy Cross Brothers and I am delighted to announce that the major relics of Saint Andre Bessette will be making a visit to Saint Cecilia's on September 24th. We will officially receive them at the 11:15 am Mass and schedule veneration throughout the rest of the day. Just last weekend, I was speaking to one of our parishioners who remembers meeting Brother Andre when she was a little girl. The effect he had on so many peoples' lives, bringing healing through the intercession of Saint Joseph, remains a great blessing to this day!

This Monday, May 22nd, we will be welcoming Bishop McManus for the celebration of the sacrament of confirmation. 93 candidates will be confirmed from Saint Cecilia's, Holy Family, Holy Trinity, Our Lady of the Lake, Saint Anna's, Saint Leo's, Immaculate Heart of Mary and Saint Boniface parishes. Please join us for this wonderful celebration!

A week from Monday is Memorial Day. On that morning at 9:30 AM we will celebrate Mass in the cemetery, weather permitting. I hope many of you can join us to pray, especially for those who have died in the past year and rest in peace at Saint Cecilia's cemetery.

Finally, I hope you are enjoying this wonderful weather as summer becomes more and more evident with each passing day! I hope you are also able to plan some free time to rest and relax in the coming months.

May God grant you much joy!






St. Cecilia's Memorial Day Services will be held on Monday, May 29 at 9:00 am at the Cemetery.


For us to offer Rocky Railway at our parish we will need your help. Here are some ways to help:

THE STRENGTH OF THIS SAVING FOOD



The closing prayer for today's Mass asks God to increase in us "the fruits of this paschal Sacrament and pour into our hearts the strength of this saving food."

The Eucharist as a source of strength. This is a repeated theme in the prayers of the *Roman Missal*, wherein the Eucharist is described as "strength for the weak," the Bread of Life which "restores our strength," and gives us "strength to face future trials with fortitude." The Eucharist strengthens concord, unity and peace and the love of husband and wife for each other.

Strengthened by the blessing of your Sacraments, we pray, O Lord, that through them we may constantly be cleansed of our faults and, by following Christ, hasten our steps upward toward you.⁷

Jesus' remarkable prayer for Saint Peter at the Last Supper sheds light on the Eucharist as a source of strength. At the end of the meal, he says: "Simon, Simon, behold, Satan demanded to have you, that he might sift you like wheat, but I have prayed for you that your faith may not fail; and when you have turned again, strengthen your brethren," Jesus' prayer for Simon is that through the Eucharist he has just received, the sharing in the Lord's Paschal dying and rising, he may be strong.

Jesus prays for us as well, and offers us a share in the same Eucharist through which he prayed that Saint Peter might be strengthened. He prays that the Eucharist may become for him "strength for those who are weary, worn-out and bewildered." Thus, in the words of our beloved Pope Emeritus, "by participating in the Eucharist, we experience in an extraordinary manner the prayer that Jesus prayed and prays ceaselessly for every person so that the evil which we all encounter in life may not get the upper hand and that the transforming power of Christ's death and Resurrection may act within us."

When we celebrate the Eucharist, then, in memory of the Lord, we are united to his prayer and with his Paschal Sacrifice, offered for our salvation.






