What a wonderful Fall we have in front of us! So many of you have signed up for the courses on *Saint Thérèse of Lisieux* and *The Holy Spirit in the Bible!* Then, as you will read in this bulletin, I'm offering my *Introduction to Western Liturgical Art* later this month.

Yesterday, after we celebrated the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin at the 9am Mass, Bob and Irene Conner shared some of their great work at First Concern during a reception in the Parish Center. Speaking of Pro-Life work, on Saturday, September 30th, I will be leading a Morning of Recollection at Saint Paul's Cathedral for all those good folks who work for life. Each donation will be noted on a plaque located near to the Memorial.

Work on the gutters has begun and just as soon as it is completed, we will begin painting and plastering of the interior. In fact, even before that, we have begun work on restoring the stone floor in the sanctuary. Speaking of which, if anyone would like to contribute a Memorial gift towards the restoration of the floor, that would come in very handy sooner, rather than later (hint! hint!). Two floor samples are out for testing as I type to determine the precise type of stone (we think it is either *slate* or *blue stone*) and finalize the plan for it's restoration. Then just as soon as we have the funds on hand to restore it (hint! hint!) we will begin the work. I can't wait to see what it will look like!!!

In any case, it's a busy September at the little Church on French Hill, and it's all because of the prayers God hears from you, Brother André and our dear Saint Cecilia. God bless you all for your goodness!






Attention Ladies of St. Anne

AN INTRODUCTION TO LITURGICAL ARTS


Church Architecture: Origins, and Modern Forms


