# WITH THE HELP OF SAINT CECILIA PASTORAL REFLECTIONS

Dear brothers and sisters,

It's been a busy week as scores of volunteers have been preparing for Christmas in Acadia. I just came back from the poutine kitchen where experts in eyeing, mashing, straining, spinning and forming potatoes into delicious poutines are hard at work. Last night folks were making meatballs by the hundred and our High School students were making apple pies!

The sense of enormous gratitude for all the folks who have been working for months to prepare for our major fundraiser of the year sits right behind my heart. I think of the Flea Market folks pricing thousands of items and stocking shelves for hours at a time. And so many others! Thank you!!!

Alongside the preparations for the fair, the work continues on our Church gutters. The great good news is that the work is going quicker than we had expected. If you get a chance to watch Adam's video of the building of walkways in the attic and the installation of new drains, you will get a good sense of what they have been up to. Here is the first new drain, which was installed just a few days ago.



Soon, we will begin the restoration of the floor in the new Blessed Sacrament Chapel. You may also have noticed that the wood tester which hangs over the Blessed Sacrament disappeared this week. It will return in the coming days as two testers, one in each of the side chapels. Once the Blessed Sacrament and Baptismal Font have been relocated to their new spaces, images of your favorite saints will sit beneath these two testers for our veneration and meditation

Preliminary work to secure the plaster on the column nearest the shrine of Saint Cecilia is also in the works, so that we can return the ambo to it's position and expand the seating for lay ministers on that side of the sanctuary. Sometime soon, the priest's chair will also move to the other side (where the ambo is now) in preparation for the creation of the Blessed Sacrament Chapel, sometime after the first of the year.

Of course none of the painting and final plastering will take place until we have completed the waterproofing of the exterior of the building, which may have to wait until the other side of winter. All in God's good time!

Thank you for all your support through all of this. May God bring to a happy conclusion that he has so wondrously begun!





# POPE FRANCIS'S APOSTOLIC EXHORTATION ON THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF SAINT THERESE OF THE CHILD JESUS EXCERPTS - PART ONE



"It is confidence and nothing but confidence that must lead us to Love." These striking words of Saint Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face say it all. They sum up the genius of her spirituality and would suffice to justify the fact that she has been named a Doctor of the Church. Confidence, "nothing but confidence", is the sole path that leads us to the Love that grants everything. With confidence, the wellspring of grace overflows into our lives, the Gospel takes flesh within us and makes us channels of mercy for our brothers and sisters.

It is confidence that sustains us daily and will enable us to stand before the Lord on the day when he calls us to himself: "In the evening of this life, I shall appear before you with empty hands, for I do not ask you, Lord, to count my works. All our justice is stained in your eyes. I wish, then, to be clothed in your own Justice and to receive from your Love the eternal possession of yourself."

The earthly life of Saint Therese was brief, a mere twenty-four years, and completely ordinary, first in her family and then in the Carmel of Lisieux. The extraordinary burst of light and love that she radiated came to be known soon after her death, with the publication of her writings and thanks to the countless graces bestowed on the faithful who invoked her intercession.

In the name that Therese chose as a religious, Jesus stands out as the "Child" who manifests the mystery of the Incarnation, and the "Holy Face" of the one who surrendered himself completely on the Cross. She is "Saint Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face."

The name of Jesus was constantly on her lips, as an act of love, even to her last breath. She had also written these words in her cell: "Jesus is my one love." It was her interpretation of the supreme statement of the New Testament: "God is love" (1 Jn 4:8.16).


