# WITH THE HELP OF SAINT CECILIA PASTORAL REFLECTIONS

Dear brothers and sisters,

As the year draws to a close, I wanted to report to you on the finances of our beloved Saint Cecilia's parish. Here are a few of the highlights:

Income, for the first time, broke a million dollars, up 7% over the past fiscal year. Last year we brought in \$936,000, and this year it was \$1,002,996. Collections were up 2%, BINGO up 13%, Gifts up 26% and Fundraising up 4%.

We ended the fiscal year with a small surplus. Up until the end of the fiscal year, all capitol expenses for repairs of the Church was taken from our regular income, at \$209,266. Since then, we have been borrowing from the Diocesan Expansion Fund, which I am seeking to repay from a wide range of benefactors in the coming year.

As usual, more than half of our expenses are for the Church (53%), with 19% on Administration and 13% spent on the Rectory. Only 6% of our income went to pay for Religious Education expenses.

We met with great success in our efforts to reduce utilities expenses, most notably in heating, with a 23% decrease in our expenses.

We made several insurance claims in the last fiscal year, totaling \$109,945 for flooding in the rectory basement and damage to the roof in the parish hall.


All of which means that your extraordinary generosity has once again helped us to build the next chapter in the history of this beloved Church. We hope to continue to find ways to save even more on utilities and to solicit large foundation grants to help with the exterior of the Church.

As for the interior renovations (set to begin once the gutter work is completed in the spring), we have well over a million dollars on hand, between insurance money and Memorial donations. In order that we might accomplish as much as possible in these interior renovations, I have decided to extend the Memorial solicitation until May 1<sup>st</sup> of 2024. That means that you still have the opportunity to donate memorials in memory of your loved ones which will stand for generations to come. You will find additional memorial brochures at each of the entrances.

Thank you for your support of Worcester's largest Church and this vital parish community. I am certain that God will bless us in even greater ways in the coming year!


