CALLED TO HIGHER THINGS

Think about a typical day for you. From the time you awake until your day ends, you may be busy, focused on work or family with little time to pause except perhaps a few moments for lunch or dinner. Most of us would say this is an accurate description of life as we know it. And if we are honest with ourselves, we see much good that comes from the attention we pay to the people in our lives and the tasks that we accomplish. We may even be mindful of our call to do these things with and through the Lord as we go about our lives. Yet we must remember that we are also called to higher things. We are in the world but not of it. Our ultimate goal is to be with God for eternity, and all our activities, tasks, and interactions must bear this great purpose in mind.

THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS AT HAND

Jesus sent the seventy-two to proclaim the kingdom of God. They were to show people God's love by the way in which they lived. They were to travel simply, with only the provisions that were needed, rely on the good will of the people they served, and care for those who were in need. While some of us are called to live as missionaries, visiting places far from the comfort of home, most of us are called to live faithfully in our daily lives, where we are, with family and friends, co-workers, fellow citizens of our local towns and cities, our country, and the world. Whether we go to far-off lands to serve and share Christ's message of mercy or we serve in simple ways at home and in our local place, we must remember that whenever we reach out to heal, forgive, and show compassion, the kingdom of God is at hand. Christ is with us and will remain with us.

All classes begin mid-September and run through mid-May.

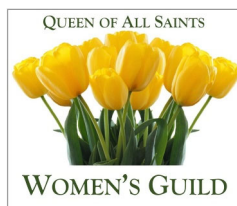
Catechist meetings and training will take place throughout August.

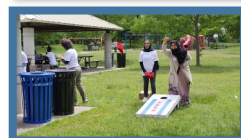
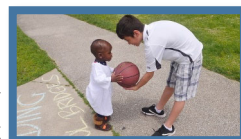

Let's face it - Chicago weather has its challenges. And unless you've been here a few summers, you are unprepared for the blistering heat. It is no different for our newcomers. Their townhome does not have central air conditioning or window units. A few weeks ago, our Building Peaceful Bridges team made a quick dash to Home Depot to secure a few of the last box fans available. Many people have asked how they can help and this is one way - if you have any working window air conditioning units that you don't need, please leave a note at moira@buildingpeacefulbridges.org. We have received one donation of a standing unit for their living room, which was so appreciated.

The three families are otherwise doing fairly well. June 20 was World Refugee Day, which they celebrated quietly, grateful that they have found a safe place to live. Basharmal has finished his ESL classes and has signed up for accounting classes to pursue a master's degree in accounting. He also hopes to find an internship while going to school, in order to earn money for the families. In the last few weeks, he needed emergency dental work. Generously responding to the call was a QAS parishioner who was able to perform the necessary dental procedures with just a day's notice. Such a remarkable gift!



To celebrate World Refugee Day as an organization, Building Peaceful Bridges sponsored a Family Fun Day at Lovelace Park. The pictures on the page capture some of the joy the children had getting together and playing with other refugee families. QAS seventh graders collected first aid supplies for them, which were distributed at the event, along with toiletries from the St. Vincent de Paul collection.

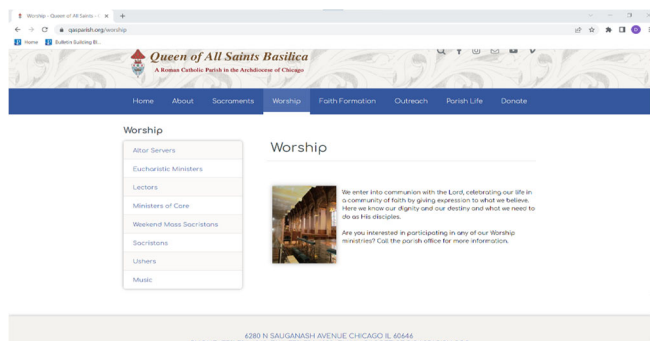

STEWARDSHIP OF OUR RESOURCES AIR CONDITIONING

Are you comfortable at Mass?

With July temperatures normally ranging from merely warm to outright nasty, you might hesitate before going out your door, but you know that our basilica will be a place where we can all worship together as one family in grateful celebration of all that God has given us.

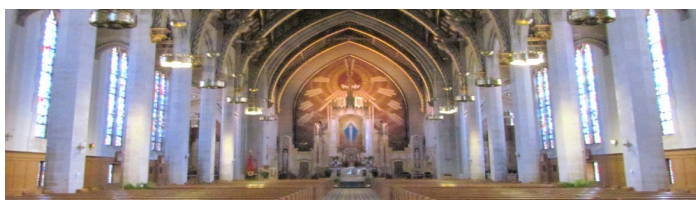
You also know that we can gather without the distraction of the heat and humidity that can affect us all, especially our elderly and disabled.

It is due to the generosity of our fellow parishioners that we are able to focus on the essentials of our faith at Mass, and fully experience the dedicated work of our music ministry, our celebrants and homilists, our ushers, and all others who make our weekend services a rewarding and joyful experience.

We hope you read Fr. Simon's letter in last week's bulletin about our air conditioning resource, an over 60-year-old system which we depend upon to cool a very large volume of air seven days a week. That system is on its last legs and will need to be finally replaced at a cost of \$700,000. Our plan is to fund this project out of our operating budget over the next few years but that will require the continued generous support of our parishioners.

Our electric bills and other ongoing expenses of our basilica are also paid for out of our operating budget. Please remember this when you consider your level of weekly Sunday support for our parish.

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the sacrament of baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism, or visit our website for our baptism dates and the baptism registration form. The sacrament of baptism for infants is celebrated on Sundays. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory with any questions or for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the anointing of the sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.

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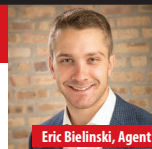
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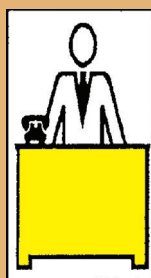
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
