About the Pew Missals/Hymnals

Last year because of the COVID-19 limitations we did not have missals in the pews like we used to. We also went over to another company and had them available for parishioners to purchase and take with them. The Ignatius Pew Missal is a single volume for the whole year and includes the Sunday readings, the hymns and - for the English version - the antiphons for all the daily Masses. It also has devotional prayers in the back including the prayers on the inside of the back page that we use for Eucharistic Adoration.

As conditions have changed and missals are allowed in the Church you will see them back in the pews. However, some things that we did during the worst of the pandemic had hidden benefits. The missals are one example. Not being able to have them in the pews for multiple people to touch and so on led to what we did last year. But it also meant that parishioners could take a missal with them and prepare for the coming Sunday, or look back to previous ones, and it could be used as inexpensive devotional book. That is something that I would like to continue and want to encourage.

This year we will be ordering enough for the pews and we will also offer some for purchase at \$5.00 each. I also encourage you to look into buying a subscription for *Magnificat* or

The Word Among Us, or other periodicals that serve as guides for Mass and that will also have lessons and inspiring articles in them. I have also encouraged the purchase of a hand Missal, such as the Midwest Theological Forum version that you have seen me use. Not only does it have all the readings for every Sunday (Years A-B-C) and Daily Masses (Years I-II) it also has an extensive section of devotional material.



The use of hand missals was more common in the past when most of the Mass was celebrated in Latin. The pandemic did bring the practice back to us for another reason and I think that it is a good thing to continue with. Not everyone will want to have a copy of their own and visitors can also benefit from having missals in the pews. Please consider buying one for yourself or getting a permanent hand missal or subscription.

Last week some information about the requirements and scheduling of Baptisms was posted. This week is just a taste of the richness of Holy Baptism from the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

- 1276** “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you” (Mt 28:19–20).
- 1277** Baptism is birth into the new life in Christ. In accordance with the Lord’s will, it is necessary for salvation, as is the Church herself, which we enter by Baptism.
- 1278** The essential rite of Baptism consists in immersing the candidate in water or pouring water on his head, while pronouncing the invocation of the Most Holy Trinity: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- 1279** The fruit of Baptism, or baptismal grace, is a rich reality that includes forgiveness of original sin and all personal sins, birth into the new life by which man becomes an adoptive son of the Father, a member of Christ and a temple of the Holy Spirit. By this very fact the person baptized is incorporated into the Church, the Body of Christ, and made a sharer in the priesthood of Christ.
- 1280** Baptism imprints on the soul an indelible spiritual sign, the character, which consecrates the baptized person for Christian worship. Because of the character Baptism cannot be repeated (cf. DS 1609 and DS 1624).
- 1281** Those who die for the faith, those who are catechumens, and all those who, without knowing of the Church but acting under the inspiration of grace, seek God sincerely and strive to fulfill his will, can be saved even if they have not been baptized (cf. LG 16).
- 1282** Since the earliest times, Baptism has been administered to children, for it is a grace and a gift of God that does not presuppose any human merit; children are baptized in the faith of the Church. Entry into Christian life gives access to true freedom.
- 1283** With respect to children who have died without Baptism, the liturgy of the Church invites us to trust in God’s mercy and to pray for their salvation.

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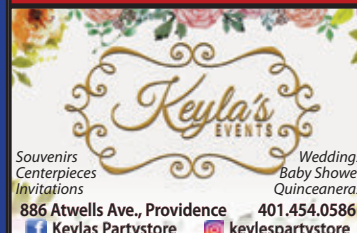
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
