

Exploration Stations Supplies List

Discovery Center

- Play dough
- Animal cookie cutters
- Small plastic animals
- Real or fake leaves, pinecones, safe nature stuff
- Variety of safe time pieces such as rubber stamp clocks, educational clocks with movable hands, watches, stopwatches, play clocks, egg timers, sand timers from games, and alarm clocks.
- Washable ink pads
- Blindfold
- Pillowcase or mystery box with safe items to feel, such as a soft brush, spoon, plastic cup, ball, stuffed animal, sock, and washable marker
- Cotton balls
- Glue sticks
- Foil cut into small squares

Touch Table

- Under-the-bed storage container, small wading pool, or “official” touch table
- Tarp or plastic tablecloth
- Play sand (not regular sand—from hardware store)
- Cookie cutter shapes (circles and triangles needed in particular)
- Wet wipes for cleanup
- Sand toys (rakes, buckets, funnels, plastic cups, etc.)
- Red and green play dough
- Christmas cookie cutters such as stars, angels, bells, and candles
- Safe Christmas items to press into the play dough to make impressions
- Nuts, bolts, screws, gears, washers, etc.
- Plastic clear cups and/or buckets
- egg cartons
- Play gems
- Crowns
- Glow sticks
- Party supplies

Dramatic Play

- Light brown roll paper or light brown plastic tablecloths
- Stuffed or rubber animals, fake trees and plants
- Bible-time props such as baskets and play food (Bible-time foods in particular, like fruit, veggies, grains)
- Bible-time headdresses (see craft guide) and tunics
- Manger and baby doll, baby supplies
- Manger animal costumes
- Variety of building supplies (possibilities include cardboard bricks, blocks, lunch bag blocks [see text], milk carton blocks [rinse milk cartons well],
- Play tools, play workbench,
- Carpenter’s tool belts or aprons
- Play hard hats
- Streets of gold (yellow sheets or tablecloths taped down, or corrugated cardboard sheets painted yellow and taped down)
- Play gems
- Party hats

Coloring Corner

- Markers (glow-in-the-dark or neon)
- Additional supplies to glue on, stickers
