SACRAMENTS FOR THE SICK

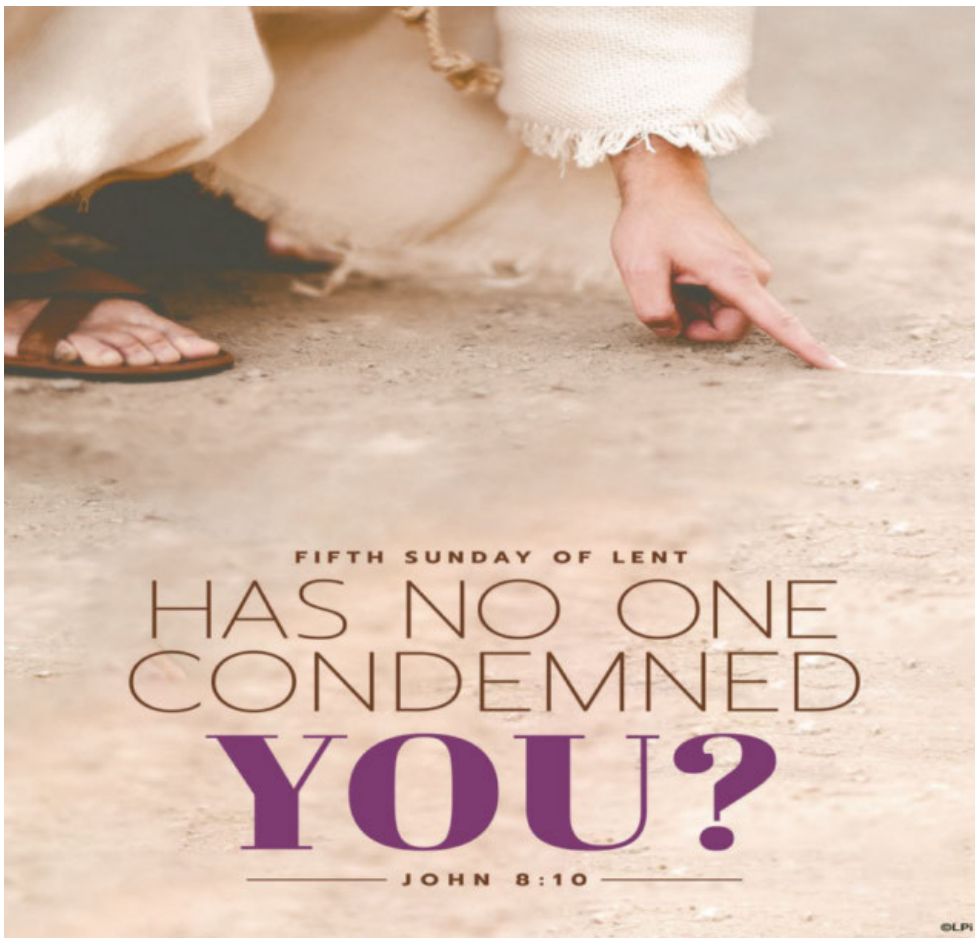
Please notify the parish office if someone is ill at home or in the hospital.

As we prepare to journey through Holy Week, we are invited to walk with Christ through His suffering, death, and resurrection. For those who have experienced the loss of a loved one, this sacred time can bring both sorrow and solace. The Passion of Christ reminds us that even in the depths of agonizing grief, we are never alone. Jesus, who wept at the tomb of Lazarus, understands our pain. He walks with us in our suffering, carrying our burdens with love and compassion. By lovingly walking with others in their grief, we honor the support we received during our own times of loss and help create a compassionate community.

In the Gospel of John, Jesus speaks words of profound comfort: "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live." (John 11:25-26). These words remind us that death is not the end, and that in Christ, we find the promise of eternal life. Though our hearts may ache, we are called to trust in the hope of the resurrection.

Psalms 34:18 reassures us, "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and those who are crushed in spirit he saves." In our moments of deepest sorrow, God is near. He offers us His presence, His peace, and His promise that love never ends.

As we reflect on the mystery of Holy Week and look forward to the season of Easter, let's bring our grief to the foot of the cross. There, in the sacrifice of Christ, we find redemption. There, in His empty tomb, we find hope. And in His resurrection, we find the assurance that we will be reunited with those we love.

May this Holy Week and Easter be a time of healing, as we entrust our sorrows to Christ and allow His light to guide us forward in faith. Amen.

ministerio de pérdida y curación

Mientras nos preparamos para recorrer la Semana Santa, se nos invita a caminar con Cristo a través de su sufrimiento, muerte y resurrección. Para quienes han experimentado la pérdida de un ser querido, este tiempo sagrado puede traer tanto dolor como consuelo. La Pasión de Cristo nos recuerda que, incluso en las profundidades del dolor agonizante, nunca estamos solos. Jesús, que lloró ante la tumba de Lázaro, comprende nuestro dolor. Él camina con nosotros en nuestro sufrimiento, llevando nuestras cargas con amor y compasión. Cuando acompañamos amorosamente a los demás en su dolor, honramos el apoyo que hemos recibido durante nuestros propios momentos de dolor y pérdida, y ayudamos a crear una comunidad compasiva.

En el Evangelio de Juan, Jesús pronuncia palabras de profundo consuelo: «Yo soy la resurrección y la vida; el que cree en mí, aunque muera, vivirá» (Juan 11:25-26). Estas palabras nos recuerdan que la muerte no es el final, y que en Cristo encontramos la promesa de la vida eterna. Aunque nos duela el corazón, estamos llamados a confiar en la esperanza de la resurrección.

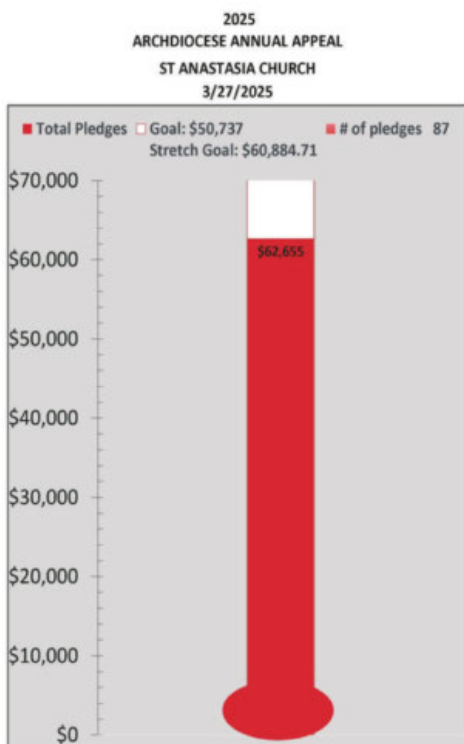

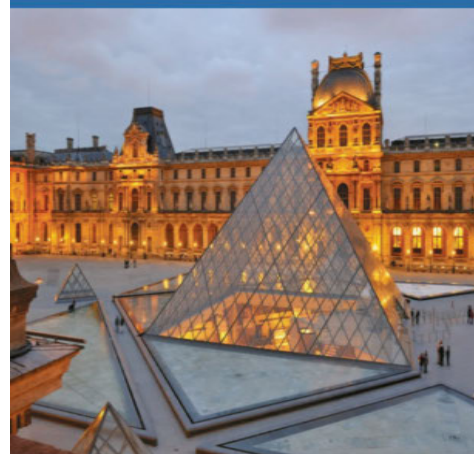
