Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Once again our Lord reveals Himself as the Good Shepherd. We read in today's Gospel: *His heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd.*

The Old Testament spoke of God as shepherd of his people, Israel. *The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want* (Psalm 23:1). *Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, you who lead Joseph like a flock!* (Psalm 80:1) *We are his people, and the sheep of his pasture* (Psalm 100:3). The Messiah is also presented as the shepherd of God's people: *he will feed his flock like a shepherd, he will gather the lambs in his arms* (Isaiah 40:11). Jesus told his disciples that he was the Good Shepherd who was willing to lay down his life for his sheep (Matthew 18:12, Luke 15:4, John 10). His love was a personal love for each and every person who came to him in need. Saint Peter called Jesus the *Shepherd and Guardian of our souls* (1 Peter 2:25), because in the person of the Lord Jesus we see the unceasing vigilance and patience of God's love. In our battle against sin and evil, Jesus is ever ready to give us help, strength, and refuge.

Saint Augustine beautifully explains that Jesus, the good shepherd, feeds us with the words of God: "The pastures that this good shepherd has prepared for you, in which he has settled you for you to take your fill, are not various kinds of grasses and green things, among which some are sweet to the taste, some extremely bitter, which as the seasons succeed one another are sometimes there and sometimes not. Your pastures are the words of God and His commandments, and they have all been sown as sweet grasses. These pastures had been tasted by that man who said to God, 'How sweet are your words to my palate, more so than honey and the honeycomb in my mouth!' (Psalm 119:103)."

Let us pray that the Lord, may help us to stand firm in his word and to trust in his help in all circumstances. May we always find rest and refuge in the shelter of his presence.

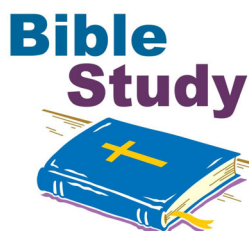

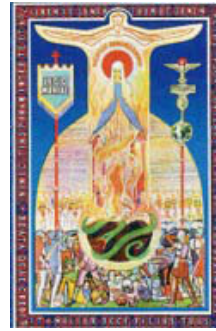

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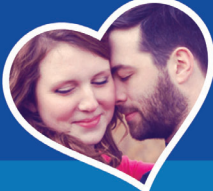
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
