Dear brothers and sisters,

In today's Gospel our Lord sends his disciples: *he sent them ahead of Him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit.*

Then He gave some indications about how to proceed in their mission. To pray, to be poor, to bring peace. And more importantly he made it clear that the main fruit of our missionary life is the salvation of souls: *do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven.*

Also, we must say that the consolation of the missionary is the imitation of Christ. We rejoice in the fact that we can be Christ for others. St. Teresa of Avila wrote:

Christ has no body but yours,
No hands, no feet on earth but yours,
Yours are the eyes with which he looks
Compassion on this world,
Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good,
Yours are the hands, with which he blesses all the world.
Yours are the hands, yours are the feet,
Yours are the eyes, you are His body.
Christ has no body now, but yours,
No hands, no feet on earth but yours,
Yours are the eyes with which he looks with compassion on this world.
Christ has no body now on earth but yours.

Dear brothers and sisters, such is the treasure that we have in our baptism, we are ministers, we are missionaries of Christ, and this is our unavoidable task.

Let us pray that we may generously give example of Christian life to all those around us, so that we may finally enjoy the presence of our King forever in heaven. May our blessed Mother the Queen of missionaries, intercede for us.

The painting is finishing up at the Fitzgerald Building. The flooring will be going down next. Plans are being finalized on the smoke detector system. Once the plans are finalized the wiring will be run and the system installed.

Window bids are being reviewed and hope to finalize soon. Thank you to the 7 parishioners who have stepped forward and have donated a window. All large and small contributions are very much appreciated to help with the costs of the windows. The old windows in the rest of the Fitzgerald building need replacement in order to make the building more energy efficient. We will replace them as funds are available.

The contract for the access approaches from the 5th street sidewalk to the Church and Xavier Hall entrances eliminating all steps at the sidewalk has been awarded to Clint Adams Concrete.

We hope to get a group of parishioner together to paint the back wall and closet rooms in the Upper Room the end of July or the first part of August.. The walkway going from 2nd floor Xavier Hall into the narthex of the church also needs to be painted.

Tin Mừng Chúa Giêsu Kitô theo Thánh Luca. Khi ấy, Chúa chọn thêm bảy mươi hai người nữa, và sai các ông cứ từng hai người đi trước Người, đến các thành và các nơi mà chính Người sẽ tới. Người bảo các ông rằng: "Lúa chín đầy đồng mà thợ gặt thì ít; vậy các con hãy xin chủ ruộng sai thợ đến gặt lúa của Người. Các con hãy đi. Nay Ta sai các con như con chiên ở giữa sói rừng. Các con đừng mang theo túi tiền, bao bì, giày dép, và đừng chào hỏi ai dọc đường. Vào nhà nào, trước tiên các con hãy nói: 'Bình an cho nhà này'. Nếu ở đây có con cái sự bình an, thì sự bình an của các con sẽ đến trên người ấy. Bằng không, sự bình an lại trở về với các con. Các con ở lại trong nhà đó, ăn uống những thứ họ có, vì thợ đáng được trả công. Các con đừng đi nhà này sang nhà nọ. "Khi vào thành nào mà người ta tiếp các con, các con hãy ăn những thức người ta dọn cho. Hãy chữa các bệnh nhân trong thành và nói với họ rằng: 'Nước Thiên Chúa đã đến gần các ngươi'. {"Khi vào thành nào mà người ta không tiếp đón các con, thì hãy ra giữa các phố chợ và nói: 'Cả đến bụi đất thành các ngươi dính vào chân chúng tôi, chúng tôi cũng xin phui trả lại các ngươi. Nhưng các ngươi hãy biết rõ điều này: Nước Thiên Chúa đã đến gần'. Ta bảo các con, ngày ấy, thành Sôđôma sẽ được xử khoan dung hơn thành này". Bảy mươi hai ông trở về rất vui mừng và nói rằng: "Thưa Thầy, nhân danh Thầy thì cả ma quỷ cũng vâng phục chúng con". Người bảo: "Ta đã thấy Satan từ trời sa xuống như luồng chớp. 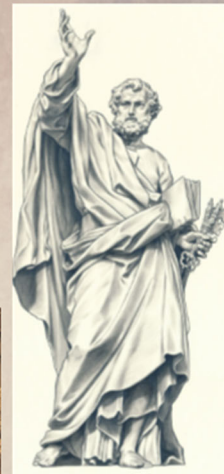

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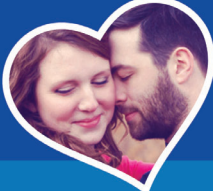
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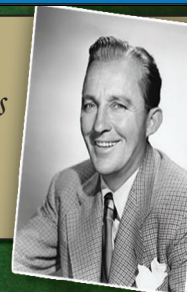


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
