

I know that many of you feel the lack of normalcy inherent in not being able to come to daily or even Sunday Mass, but I pray that this trial will grant us all a greater love for the Eucharist. As with so many other blessings in life, we often come to a greater appreciation of what we habitually have when the status quo is disrupted. Remember that God uses all things providentially for the good of those who love him, as St. Paul reminds us in the Letter to the Romans (Cf. Romans 8:28). We choose our friends, but God chooses our parents and children, brothers and sisters. Let yourself be reminded how important God and your family are. See the Father's hand in everything, especially in what we cannot control. I hope you are all doing well and staying healthy. Please God, we will be together again soon.


Lenten Almsgiving


With great openness and courage, we need to question how widespread is the culture of life today among individual Christians, families, groups and communities in our Diocese. With equal clarity and determination

The Rosaries you pray this week will be for mothers facing an unexpected pregnancy as she prepares to encounter Christ anew through the gift of the child.




