Parish Information

We welcome you to the Good Shepherd Parish Community!

Please register at the Parish Office as soon as you are able to do so, and the staff will be happy to inform you about our parish and the opportunities we offer. Parish registration is required for religious education, celebration of all Sacraments and certification as a sponsor for Baptism and Confirmation. Regular Sunday worship with us indicates a practicing Catholic, not just parish registration. Attendance is necessary at weekend worship for the all sacraments and certification of sponsorship. Please notify the parish office of any changes in phone numbers, addresses, e-mail addresses or when leaving the parish.

Baptism: All Baptisms are celebrated on the first Sunday of the month at **12noon**. The preparation process should begin at least three months before the planned date of the Baptism. A Baptism Preparation Class is required for parents (godparents may attend if they wish). This class is offered on the fourth Sunday of each month at **9:45 AM**. Please call the parish office to register. The date of the baptism is scheduled after attending the class. Parish membership and active worship is required for two months prior to preparation.

Religious Education: We provide faith filled instructions for Levels 1st through 8th. There are times, due to Covid-19 we must implement virtual instruction, otherwise our program is offered in person. Special instructions are given for sacramental preparations.

Initiation of Adults and Older Children: This is an extended formation process for unbaptized or uncatechized adults or baptized Christians of other faith traditions who wish to become members of the Catholic Church, as well as for unbaptized or uncatechized school-aged children. Please contact the parish office for more information. Initiation is celebrated at the Easter Vigil after a formation period of one or two years.

Adult Confirmation: This is a program for persons over the age of 18 who have received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Eucharist, but who never completed their initiation with the Sacrament of Confirmation. The program is a 10-12 week program, with Confirmation being celebrated on the Solemnity of Pentecost. Please call the parish office for more details.

Matrimony: Couples wishing to marry in Good Shepherd Parish must be registered members of our parish. They are required to make initial arrangements at least one year in advance. Four sessions with the priest or deacon, as well as Pre-Cana or Engaged Encounter take place during this year. Active worship for at least two months are required before a date may be scheduled.

Anointing of the Sick: Anyone who is seriously ill or unable to come to church for a length of time should contact the parish office to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick. Eucharistic Ministers bring Holy Communion to homebound parishioners every Sunday, and our priest will visit on the First Friday of each month. Please call the parish office to make arrangements. The Diocese of Metuchen provides Catholic priests to serve at all local hospitals.







INTERCESSION

Intercessory prayer is the act of praying on behalf of others. All Christians are called to be Intercessory. Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Ootacamund (India)

This weekend Fr. Thomas Rayar, a native of India currently serving in Minnesota, will be in our parish to make a mission appeal for the Diocese of Ootacamund, India.

The diocese of Ootacamund was established in 1955 in the mountainous area of Tamil Nadu State in India by Pope Pius XII. It has a Catholic population of c.98,000 which would be 5% of the total population of that area. About 150 priests and 415 religious nuns serve in about 70 parishes and 22 high schools in this diocese. About two third of the faithful of the diocese are illiterate and mostly daily-wage laborers and farmers earning about \$4 a day with which the families can not afford to send their children to school.

Apart from people with different cultures, the diocese is endowed with different aboriginal tribes both in Nilgiris and Erode districts. These tribal people do not have opportunities for education. More than 38% of the population are illiterate. As there are no proper roads to the hilly tribal villages, we have established boarding schools in the small towns where the tribal children could have education.

By God's grace, we have been blessed with a great number of vocations for priests and nuns. However, with our meager resources we find it difficult to support our Seminarians to prepare for their priesthood. The funds raised from this appeal will specifically be spent for the room and board, and educational expenses of these poor children and for the education of the seminarians of our diocese. Thank you for your generosity! May God bless you for your sacrificial support to the mission and your prayers for evangelization of our global Church!




