Hope - Hope is the trust that somehow, one way or another, even when things don't seem to be working out and are very difficult, our future is in God's hands.

Face Masks: Everyone must wear a face mask in the church. Face masks are now mandatory in indoor public spaces to stop the spread of COVID-19, this includes all worship spaces and churches. This order was issued for Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit this week.

There will be <u>exceptions to the requirement</u>, for instance children under the age of two, or people who are medically or physically unable to put on a mask. Officials will rely on the good faith of individuals who say they are unable to wear a mask. <u>Note</u> that wearing a face mask is in addition to our social distancing.

<u>Parishioners should bring their own face mask</u>. Should some parishioners not be aware of the order and not be prepared, we have a limited supply of masks which we can make available.

All those involved in ministries, must wear a mask except when they are required to speak or sing to fulfil their ministry.
