### **Mass Obligations for Christmas 2023**

The Archdiocese of Kingston has sent a reminder about Mass obligations this year: Christmas is always a holy day of obligation and this year it falls on a Monday, immediately following the Fourth Sunday of Advent. The two separate obligations to attend Mass (one for the Fourth Sunday of Advent and one for Christmas) are both important and are met by attending two separate Masses. The Sunday obligation can be fulfilled by attending Mass on Saturday evening or any time on Sunday. The Christmas obligation can be fulfilled at Mass on Sunday evening or any time on Monday. However, the same Mass cannot meet both obligations.

In addition to giving cash, you will also have the opportunity to make a donation using the QR code with your smart phone. The code will be on the table.






#### Seeking Volunteers
