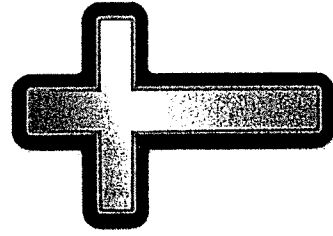

FROM FATHER TONY:

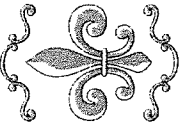
Dear Friends,
