Acceptable donations:

Medicine bottle caps/(info packet removed), milk jug, creamer caps, detergent caps, hair spray caps, toothpaste caps, deodorant caps, apple sauce pouch cap, drink bottle caps soda, water, juice caps, sports drink: flip-top caps (Ketchup), spout caps (mustard), spray paint caps, ointment tube caps, baby food caps, shampoo/conditioner caps.

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Don’t forget the Baby Bottles in vestibule for Heart to Heart. This organization is a line of defense against the lies that would encourage women to abort their children. They listen and love. They provide pregnancy tests and ultrasounds and loving counsel. Because of people like us who give and support them, all their services are FREE.

Once a woman has made a choice to parent, they provide her with prenatal education, labor and delivery preparation and basic newborn child care. She can remain a client until her child is 2 years of age. They continue her education with parenting lessons and childcare formation.

Each woman receives a voucher every time she comes. She can also receive vouchers for working and educating herself. With these vouchers she can provide diapers, wipes, clothing, car seats and cribs.

For those who have been hurt by abortion they offer Post Abortion Recovery. It is never too late to find the love and forgiveness of Jesus and healing. He is greater than our deepest wounds!

## Diocesan policy: Report and inform

The Diocese of Evansville has in place a policy that requires that any allegation of child abuse must be reported to civil authorities. If an allegation involves the sexual abuse of a minor by diocesan personnel, the Victim Assistance Coordinator must also be informed.

Sexual misconduct violates human dignity and the mission of the church. The spiritual well-being of all victims, their families, and others in the community is of particular concern to the church.

## Report child abuse

Every allegation of child abuse must be reported to child Protection Services, an agency of Indiana state government.

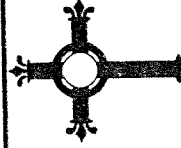
