Holy Week

Dear Friends,

With this Palm Sunday we are embarking on the most sacred and hallowed days of our liturgical calendar. Fr. Tony and I encourage you to enter as fully as possible into the mysteries of Holy Week. Let this Holy Week lead you into greater holiness – let this be the “most Lenten” week of your Lent. Have you slacked on your prayer, fasting, and almsgiving? Have you forgotten to rend your hearts and not returned to the LORD, your God with your whole heart? There is still time. The Church, as she always does, provides concrete ways to enter more fully into this sacred time. Here they are:

Palm Sunday/Passion Sunday

We commemorate Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD! Yet in our Gospel we get right into his Passion and death.

Tuesday – Chrism Mass

The most under-the-radar day of Holy Week. At 5 p.m. at St. Benedict Cathedral in Evansville at 5:30 p.m. CENTRAL time all of the priests will gather to celebrate the Eucharist and renew their priestly promises. A shared anniversary of sorts for all of our priests. Bishop Siegel will bless all of the Holy oils that will be used for sacraments in the coming year. Please come join us! Our Tuesday night Mass at St. Philip Neri is cancelled so that everyone can come.

Holy Thursday: 6:00pm at St. Philip Neri

We commemorate the Last Supper and Jesus washing the feet of his disciples. The priesthood and the Eucharist are instituted on this most sacred night. We shouldn't overlook that we can't have one without the other. We begin the Easter Triduum – one three day celebration of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

Good Friday: 6:00 pm at St. Philip Neri

Jesus is put to death and we venerate the cross by which he earns our salvation! This is a communion service – a continuation of the Easter Triduum.

Holy Saturday

The liturgical climax of everything it means to be a follower of Jesus Christ. All of salvation history, and all of Heaven and Earth converge in our celebration of Christ's triumph over death. We welcome the newest members of our faith on this most sacred night. Won't you come celebrate with us?

Easter Sunday: 9:00am at St. Philip Neri

The tomb is empty – Christ is risen! It is our life's work to share this truth with everyone.
