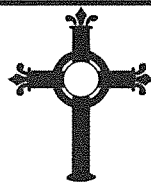

From Fr. Garrett:

Theology of the Body (#5 of 5) – Naked without Shame

Review:

- #1 of 5 – Created for Love – We are uniquely created to give & receive God's love – body & soul.
- #2 of 5 – Sacramental Worldview – We encounter God through the physical world – love incarnate.
- #3 of 5 – Marriage & Sex – Spouses are sacramentally bonded (body & soul) to get the family to heaven.
- #4 of 5 – Dating – Dating is for finding a spouse, and marriage is for heaven. Dating has a purpose!

Moving Forward:

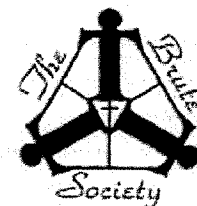
Immediately after creating man and woman in his image and likeness, Genesis 2:25 says, "The man and his wife were both naked, yet they felt no shame." Just seven verses later in Genesis 3:7, the tune changes: "Then the eyes of both them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made loincloths for themselves." What's the difference? Of course, we know, that Adam and Eve have just given into the serpents lies to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. And here is on the most cunning tricks of the devil – to make us ashamed of ourselves.

Particularly with our sexuality – one of the greatest gifts God has given us, the devil wants to make us ashamed of ourselves, our bodies, our sexuality, and where we've been. It seems to me that sexual sin in particular prevents us from recognizing our identity as beloved sons and daughters of the Father. If we forget this key part of our identity that is rightfully ours, or if we feel unredeemable because of our sexual sin, we fail to see God's unfathomable mercy!

Let us call to mind the parable of the Prodigal Son, who "swallowed up [his father's] property with prostitutes," yet was forgiven and restored to his rightful place as a beloved son. Perhaps more than any other sin the sacrament of confession is uniquely suited to restore us to not being ashamed of our bodies. For embodied sin, we need an embodied encounter with mercy. This is true for high school students, and it's true for all of us. If we're too ashamed to confess sexual sin of any kind, we're still hiding in the garden behind loincloths...and ultimately we're hiding from God. Our purity, our chastity, and our identity as beloved sons and daughters must be reclaimed if we want to receive God's love, to return that love, and to love others the way we are called to. And that is what we were created for.
