

Fourth Sunday of Lent, 2021

The Gospel for this weekend from John has this key phrase I want to explain a bit: Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up.

This story John is referencing is found in Numbers. The Israelites were grumbling against God and Moses in the desert, so God says, "Here's something worth complaining about..." And he sends snakes to bite them.

Seeing this, Moses says, "Um, Lord, I appreciate the support, but I think this will cause the people to rise up against me."

God replies, "Yeah, probably will. Fine. Make a bronze serpent and lift it up on a pole for them to look at. They'll be healed, and the snakes will go away."

Moses asks, "Why would you want them to look at an image of what is hurting them?" God responds, "How can you be healed unless you look directly at what is hurting you?"



This serpent on a pole, the *Nehushtan*, transformed into two symbols as the Jews were later merged into the Roman Empire: the rod of Asclepius (god of medicine), and the Caduceus. Still, today, you might see them on the back of an EMS truck, or on a physician's jacket as a symbol of healing.

Just as that serpent was lifted up on a wooden pole in the desert, and the people were healed, Jesus was lifted up on a wooden cross, and we who look upon him have the ability to be healed of our deepest wounds.

En el libro de Números, Moisés hace una serpiente de bronce y la levanta en un asta, para que cuando alguien del pueblo sea mordido por una serpiente, mire a esta serpiente levantada y se sane. En el evangelio de hoy, Juan dice que de igual manera Jesús será levantado para dar vida eterna a su pueblo. Juan presenta la muerte de Jesús — un levantamiento en una cruz de madera — como una exaltación, y un lugar de curación.

Solo el amor de Jesús puede transformar nuestra vida, curar todas nuestras heridas más profundas y liberarnos de la decepción, la ira y de la queja constante. - Papa Francisco
