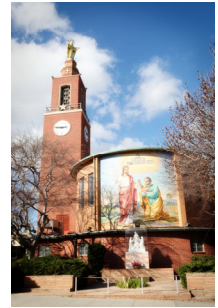

Protect against potential danger

Taking a few precautions can help children learn to protect themselves against potential danger and ease parents' minds. Teach children to memorize their full name, address, and phone number, so they can provide the information to an adult if they are separated from their parents or caregiver. Instruct children to look for a police officer or other "safe" adult (e.g., a store or park employee) if they need assistance. Teach them how and when to dial 9-1-1. 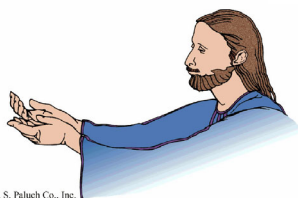
