

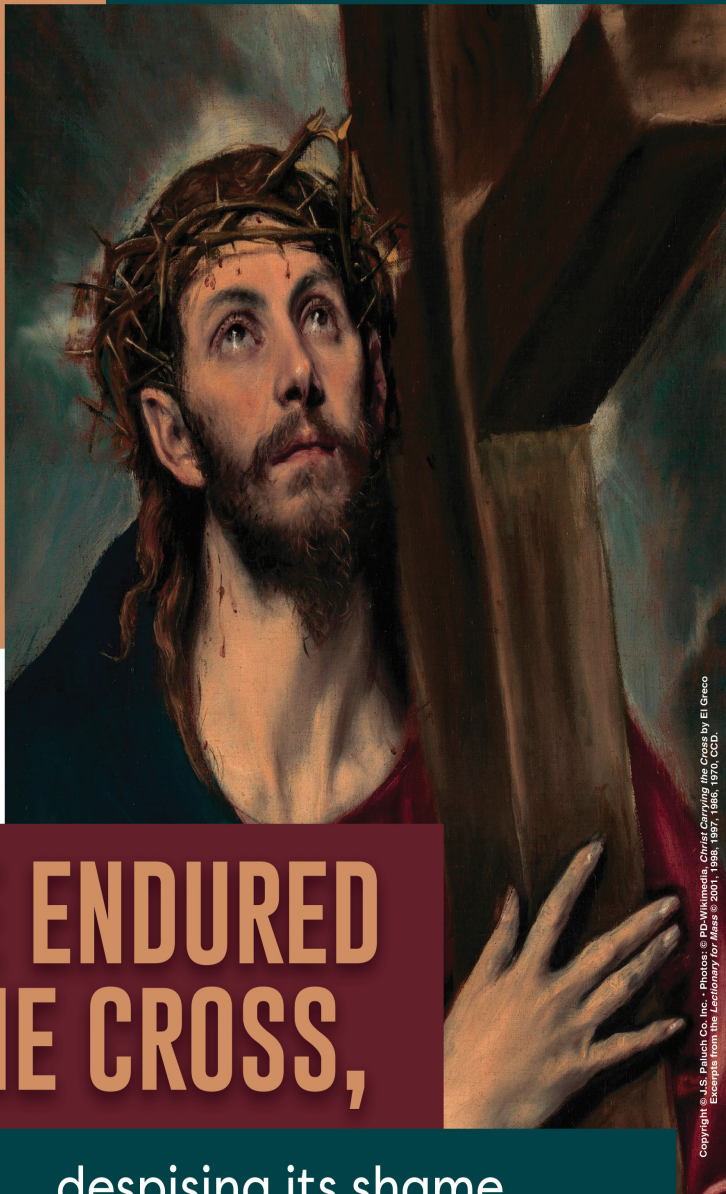

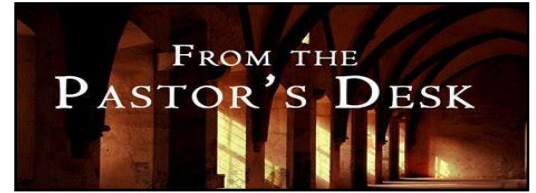


SUMMER MASS HOUR CHANGE

In praise of Mary, Mother of God

I see here a joyful company of Christian men met together in ready response to the call of Mary, the holy and ever-virgin Mother of God. The great grief that weighed upon me is changed into joy by your presence, venerable Fathers. Now the beautiful saying of David the psalmist: How good and pleasant it is for brothers to live together in unity has come true for us.

Therefore, holy and incomprehensible Trinity, we salute you at whose summons we have come together to this church of Mary, the Mother of God.

Mary, Mother of God, we salute you. Precious vessel, worthy of the whole world's reverence, you are an ever shining light, the crown of virginity, the symbol of orthodoxy, an indestructible temple, the place that held Him whom no place can contain, mother and virgin. Because of you the holy gospels could say: Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.

We salute you, for in your holy womb He, who is beyond all limitation, was confined. Because of you the holy Trinity is glorified and adored; the cross is called precious and is venerated throughout the world; the heavens exult; the angels and archangels make merry; demons are put to flight; the devil that tempter, is thrust down from heaven; the fallen race of man is taken up on high; all creatures possessed by the madness of idolatry have attained knowledge of the truth; believers receive holy baptism; the oil of gladness is poured out; the Church is established throughout the world; pagans are brought to repentance.

What more is there to say? Because of you the light of the only-begotten Son of God has shone upon those who sat in darkness and in the shadow of death; prophets pronounced the word of God; the apostles preached salvation to the Gentiles; the dead are raised to life, and kings rule by the power of the holy Trinity.

Who can put Mary's high honor into words? She is both mother and virgin. I am overwhelmed by the wonder of this miracle. Of course no one could be prevented from living in the house he had built for himself, yet who would invite mockery by asking his own servant to become his mother?

Behold then the joy of the whole universe. Let the union of God and man in the Son of the Virgin Mary fill us with awe and adoration. Let us fear and worship the undivided Trinity as we sing the praise of the ever-virgin Mary, the holy temple of God, and of God himself, her Son and spotless Bridegroom. To Him be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Devotion to Immaculate Heart

Lucia dos Santos was the eldest of the three children who saw the visions of Fatima in 1917. She was told by Our Lady, "Jesus wishes to make use of you to make me known and loved. He wants to establish in the world **devotion to my Immaculate Heart. I Promise salvation to those who embrace it, and these souls will be loved by God, like flowers placed by me to adorn His throne**". (National Catholic Register)

The Five First Saturdays Devotion is a request made by Our Lady of Fatima. The Blessed Mother promised to assist at the hour of death with the graces necessary for salvation all who, as an act of reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, **on the first five Saturdays of consecutive months:**

1. Go to confession
2. Receive Holy Communion
3. Say five decades of the rosary
4. Keep Mary company for fifteen minutes meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the rosary

The sacramental confession can be received within eight days either before or after the reception of Communion, provided the communicant is in a state of grace for Communion.

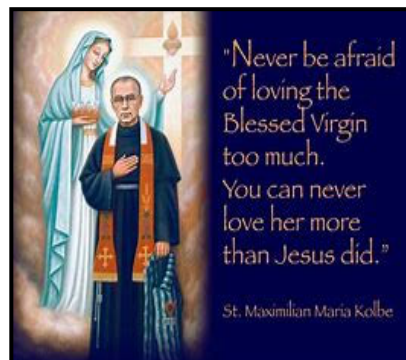
Reception of Holy Communion must take place within twenty-four hours of the first Saturday. The reception of Communion need not be part of a Mass.

The fifteen minutes of meditation are in addition to the recitation of the rosary. (Catholic.com)

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Feast day August 15th

Archaeology has revealed two tombs of Mary, one in Jerusalem and one in Ephesus. The fact that Mary lived in both places explains the two tombs. But what is inexplicable apart from the Assumption is the fact that there is no body in either tomb. And there are no relics. The belief in the communion of saints led early Christians to seek out relics from the bodies of great saints. Fragments of stories of the Assumption of Mary have been dated back to the 3rd century. Simply put, the Assumption states that at the end of her life, the Blessed Virgin Mary was taken body and soul into heaven. Pope Pius XII declared the Assumption of Mary a Dogma in 1950. 90th Anniversary of the Velike Gospe Society



The Velike Gospe Society was organized by Zorka Nizetich in 1932. She gathered a group of women of Slavic Heritage who were willing to meet socially, as well as for religious and charitable purposes to help the church. At that time Rev. Stanislav Jureko became their first Chaplain and Mrs. Nizetich was the founding president. There were 40 charter members. They organized and selected the name for their group as "The Velike Gospe Society" the name suggested by Fr. Jureko. The

name refers to our Blessed Mother's Assumption into heaven. This day the society celebrates its feast day August 15th with a Mass and procession followed by a luncheon. This year we will be celebrating on Sunday August 14th. This day has a special meaning for the Velike Society as well as the Croatian community in San Pedro. Seeing the need for a younger group, "The Velike Gospe Junior Society" was formed in 1946. Ms. Georgia Plancich was the first President. The two societies functioned separately, however the Juniors were called upon to assist their senior group at all the Mary Star of the Sea Fiesta Dinners. The Junior group eventually assumed that responsibility and in 1967 the two groups merged as one. It was through the generosity of both Senior and Junior groups that a statue of "Our Lady of the Rosary" was purchased and placed outside of the church on the Eighth Street side. In addition, a Statue of "Our Lady of the Assumption" was also purchased by the Kalooper children in honor of Ante and Goldie Kalooper. This beautiful statue can be found in the Adoration Chapel. The society has over the 90 years staged many projects and social functions for the benefit of the church. They hold a very successful bake sale the Sunday before Thanksgiving with their Croatian delicacies that they are known for. They have also set up a scholarship fund for the Mary Star of the Sea High School in memory of their deceased members. These monies are collected from the various activities such as the bake sale, bus trips, and other projects staged; the money is donated to MSHS.

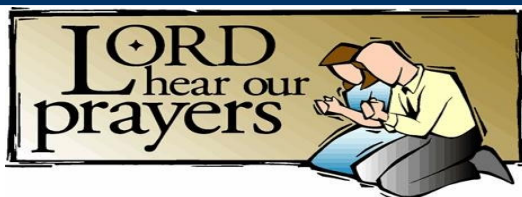

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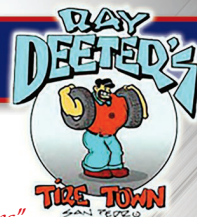
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
