

THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

One Way to Let Ourselves be Loved by God is to Repent - *Yolanda Canjura*

"This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." (Mk 1:15)

I wonder if I would have been there as a disciple in the time of our Lord Jesus and I heard those same words of Jesus: "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." (Mk 1:17); if I would have been able to say yes and would have left everything to follow him. This invitation involves losing our security, our trust in the material goods we have, distancing ourselves from our family and friends, to bet on the uncertain, on the unknown.

In Jesus' time, being a disciple meant being with the teacher, living with the teacher, walking with the teacher, learning from the teacher, and obeying the teacher with great discipline and love. This was the disciples' own reaction when they recognized Jesus as their true teacher: "Then they abandoned their nets and followed him." (M, 1:18).

To understand a little better God's invitation to do his will, to trust in God's plans more than in our own plans, I invite you to reflect on the first reading. We see how Jonah was afraid to obey God's command and promise. Humanly this plan did not make sense and Jonah did not see humanly that the conversion of the entire people was possible. Jonah also doubted the promised plan and rather was fixated on the sinful reality of the people to which he was sent.

He finally obeyed the command, even though he doubted everything that was promised. However, God did great feats through Jonah to save him, in first place, and to save all the people who lived in sin. At the end of the reading we see that God's grace saves his people through how little or how much the prophet Jonah did.

Once again, the invitation to trust fully in the promise of the Father and not in our own strengths, abilities, skills or wealth. All these earthly assurances, although necessary for living, are only fleeting realities and do not promise us eternal life. True salvation comes from God who loves us and invites us to recognize him as a Father who loves us, invites us to listen to His voice, confidently follow His plans, and obey His commandments with full certainty that one day we will be with Him for all eternity. "Then he called them. So they left their father Zebedee in the boat along with the hired men and followed him." (Mk 1:20).

The world is constantly changing and many even dare to predict the end of the world due to so many realities that we are experiencing. Many of these voices that we hear are completely filled with fear, anguish, uncertainty, loneliness, and hopelessness. But not all is lost, as the people of God we have great hope. The call of Jesus remains the same yesterday, today, and forever. His Word has not and will not change. His promise of eternal life is the same as long as we accept the invitation: "Repent, and believe in the gospel." (Mk 1:15).

In our daily life, how many and which webs prevent me from seeing Jesus, hearing His voice, and responding to His invitation? Which realities do not allow me to open myself to the grace of the Holy Spirit to accept His invitation to leave everything and follow Him?

TERCER DOMINGO EN TIEMPO ORDINARIO

UNA FORMA DE DEJARNOS AMAR POR DIOS ES ARREPINTIÉNDONOS

“Se ha cumplido el tiempo y el Reino de Dios ya está cerca. Arrepiéntanse y crean en el Evangelio” (Mc 1:15).

Me pregunto si yo hubiese estado allí como una discípula en el tiempo de nuestro señor Jesús y hubiera escuchado las mismas palabras de Jesús: “Síganme y haré de ustedes pescadores de hombres” (Mc 1:17); Si hubiera sido capaz de decir que si y hubiera dejado todo para seguirlo. Aparentemente esta invitación lleva consigo perder nuestras seguridades, nuestra confianza en las cosas materiales que tenemos, a alejarnos de nuestros familiares y amigos, para apostarle a lo incierto, a lo desconocido.

En tiempos de Jesús, ser discípulo implicaba estar con el maestro, vivir con el maestro, caminar con el maestro, aprender del maestro y obedecer al maestro con mucha disciplina y amor. Esta fue la reacción propia de los discípulos al reconocer a Jesús como su maestro verdadero: “Inmediatamente dejaron las redes y lo siguieron” (Mc 1:18).


Para entender un poco mejor la invitación de Dios a hacer su voluntad, a confiar más en los planes de Dios que en nuestros propios planes, los invito a reflexionar en la primera lectura. Vemos como Jonás tenía miedo de obedecer el mandato y la promesa de Dios. Humanamente este plan no tenía sentido y Jonás no veía humanamente que la conversión de todo un pueblo fuera posible. Jonás también dudó del plan prometido y más bien se fijaba en las realidades de pecado del pueblo a donde fue enviado.

Finalmente obedeció el mandato, aunque dudaba de todo lo prometido. Sin embargo, Dios hizo proezas a través de Jonás para salvarlo a él en primer lugar y salvar a todo el pueblo que vivía en el pecado. Al final de la lectura vemos que la gracia de Dios salva a su pueblo a través de lo poco o mucho que hizo el profeta Jonás.

Una vez más, la invitación a confiar plenamente en la promesa del padre y no en nuestras propias fuerzas, habilidades, destrezas o riquezas. Todas estas seguridades terrenales, aunque son necesarias para vivir, son solamente realidades pasajeras y no nos prometen vida eterna. La verdadera salvación viene de parte de Dios que nos ama y nos invita a reconocerlo como padre que nos ama, nos invita a escuchar su voz, seguirlo confiadamente sus planes y obedecer sus mandamientos con la plena certeza que un día estaremos con Él por toda la eternidad. “Los llamó, y ellos, dejando en la barca a su padre con los trabajadores, se fueron con Jesús” (Mc 1,20)

El mundo está en constante cambio y muchos hasta se atreven a pronosticar el fin del mundo por tantas realidades que estamos viviendo. Muchos de estas voces que escuchamos están completamente llenas de miedo, angustia, incertidumbre, soledad y desesperanza. Pero no todo está perdido, como pueblo de Dios tenemos una gran esperanza. El llamado de Jesús sigue siendo el mismo, ayer, hoy y siempre. Su palabra no ha cambiado ni cambiará. Su promesa de vida eterno es la misma siempre y cuando aceptemos la invitación: “Arrepiéntanse y crean en el Evangelio” (Mc 1:15).

¿En nuestra vida cotidiana, cuantas y cuales redes me impiden ver a Jesús, escuchar su voz y responder a su invitación? ¿Qué realidades no me permiten abrirme a la gracia del Espíritu Santo para aceptar su invitación de dejarlo todo y seguirlo?
