# Reflecting on Sunday's Readings

THE EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME—February 27, 2022

**Introduction:** Jim Downing, a friend of mine, who has since died, tells of an Oriental fable about three horsemen who were traveling through the desert at night. “*Unexpectedly they were confronted by a mysterious person. The stranger told them that they would soon cross the dry bed of a stream. ‘When you arrive there,’ he declared, ‘get off your horses and fill your pockets and saddle bags from the river bed. At sunrise examine the stones you have picked up. You will be both glad and sorry.’*

“*As the man predicted, the travelers came to a dry stream bed. In a spirit of adventure they put a few of the many stones they found scattered about, into their pockets. At sunrise the next day they examined the pebbles they had picked up. To their great astonishment they found the stones had been transformed into diamonds, rubies, emeralds and other precious stones. Recalling the statement of the stranger in the desert, they understood what he meant—they were glad for the pebbles they had picked up but sorry they hadn’t taken more.*”

We too, like the horsemen, are traveling through life, picking up stones and storing them in the pockets of our heart and mind. At the end of life’s journey, we too will be sorry or glad when we discover whether the stones we picked up are mere earth or eternally precious. This week’s Gospel reading indicates that we can get a glimpse into the future contents of these pockets by looking at the things our heart is producing now. Often it is our reactions that show what is stored there.

Much of life is thoughtful, contemplated action, wherein we determine what our response to life will be. However, occasionally, and for some frequently, we encounter the unexpected and have no time to think and act, but only to spontaneously react. Like a cup, brimming full of liquid, when it is jarred unexpectedly, whatever was put into the cup, will slosh out. So it is with these unplanned reactions. When life unexpectedly jars us, the language, attitudes, and behaviors that spill out, show us with what we are filled.

This passage also says that “*everyone when he is fully taught will be like his teacher.*” Jesus is the “master teacher,” and His life and words are pure gold, showing us who God is, how we are related to Him, and how we should relate to one another. Each of us who follows Him, desires to be like Him, and when life unexpectedly jars us, usually it is a good news, bad news situation. The good news is that five or ten years ago we would have reacted much worse. The bad news is that we still are not responding fully like Jesus would. But we have hope! For the promise of this passage is that when we are “fully” taught, we will be like our teacher. Let’s determine once again to purposely dismount from the busyness of our daily travels, to pause at the Master’s feet and pick up some precious spiritual stones.

“*It can easily be shown from examples both in the Old Testament and the New that the Spirit changes those in whom he comes to dwell; he so transforms them that they begin to live a completely new kind of life....Saint Paul writes: ‘As we behold the glory of the Lord with unveiled faces, that glory, which comes from the Lord who is the Spirit, transforms us all into his own likeness, from one degree of glory to another.’ Does that not show that the Spirit changes those in whom he comes to dwell and alters the whole pattern of their lives? With the Spirit within them it is quite natural for the people who had been absorbed by the things of this world to become entirely other-worldly in outlook, and for cowards to become men of great courage.*”

# Reflexionemos Sobre las lecturas del domingo

OCTAVO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO - 27 de febrero de 2022

**Introducción:** Jim Downing, un amigo mío que falleció recientemente contaba una fábula oriental de tres hombres que viajaban a caballo por el desierto de noche: "Inesperadamente, se vieron ante una persona misteriosa. El desconocido les dijo que pronto cruzarían el lecho de un arroyo seco. 'Cuando lleguen allí' -les dijo-, 'bájense de los caballos y llenen sus bolsillos y las alforjas de lo que hallen en el lecho del río. Al amanecer examinen las piedras que hayan recogido. Estarán contentos y lo lamentarán.'"

"Tal cual el hombre predijo, los viajeros llegaron al lecho de un arroyo seco. Con espíritu de aventura, se metieron en los bolsillos algunas de las muchas piedras que encontraron dispersas. Al amanecer del día siguiente examinaron lo que habían recogido. Para su gran sorpresa descubrieron que las piedras habían sido transformadas en diamantes, rubíes, esmeraldas y otras piedras preciosas. Recordando lo que les había dicho el extraño en el desierto, entendieron a qué se refería: se alegraron de haber recogido las piedras, pero lamentaron no haber tomado más".

Nosotros también, como los jinetes, viajamos por la vida, recogiendo piedras y almacenándolas en los bolsillos de nuestro corazón y de nuestra mente. Al final de la jornada de la vida, nosotros también nos arrepentiremos o nos alegraremos cuando descubramos si las piedras que recogimos son pura tierra o eternamente preciosas. La lectura correspondiente al Evangelio de esta semana indica que podemos vislumbrar el contenido futuro de los bolsillos al examinar las cosas que nuestro corazón está produciendo ahora. A menudo son nuestras reacciones las que muestran lo que está almacenado allí.

Gran parte de la vida es acción reflexiva y contemplativa, mediante la cual determinamos cuál será nuestra respuesta a la vida. Sin embargo, de vez en cuando, y para algunos con frecuencia, nos encontramos con lo inesperado y no tenemos tiempo para pensar y actuar, sino sólo para reaccionar espontáneamente. Como sucede cuando una copa está rebosante

de líquido y es sacudida inesperadamente, su contenido se derramará. Lo mismo ocurre con las reacciones imprevistas. **Cuando la vida nos sacude inesperadamente, el lenguaje, las actitudes y los comportamientos que se derraman, nos muestran de qué estamos llenos.**

Este pasaje también dice que "*todo el mundo, cuando esté plenamente instruido, será como su maestro*". Jesús es el "maestro supremo", y su vida y sus palabras son oro puro, mostrándonos quién es Dios, cómo nos relacionamos con Él, y cómo debemos relacionarnos unos con otros. Cada uno de nosotros que lo seguimos, desea ser como Él, y cuando la vida inesperadamente nos sacude, usualmente es una situación de buenas y malas noticias. La buena noticia es que hace cinco o diez años habríamos reaccionado mucho peor. La mala noticia es que todavía no estamos respondiendo plenamente como lo haría Jesús. ¡Pero tenemos esperanza!, porque la promesa de este pasaje es que cuando nuestro aprendizaje sea "pleno", seremos como nuestro maestro. Decidámonos una vez más a apartarnos de nuestro ajetreo cotidiano y hacer una pausa a los pies del Maestro para recoger algunas piedras preciosas espirituales.

*"Mediante los ejemplos tomados del Antiguo y del Nuevo Testamento se puede demostrar fácilmente que el Espíritu transforma a aquellos en los que viene a habitar; los transforma de tal manera que comienzan a vivir una vida completamente nueva. ... San Pablo escribe: 'Al contemplar con el rostro descubierto la gloria del*

*Señor, esa gloria, que viene del Señor que es el Espíritu, nos transforma a todos a su semejanza, de un grado de gloria a otro'. ¿No muestra eso que el Espíritu transforma a aquellos en quienes viene a morar y les altera por*

*completo su patrón de vida? Con el Espíritu dentro de ellos es muy natural que la gente que había sido absorbida por las cosas de este mundo se vuelva completamente de otro mundo, y que los cobardes se conviertan en hombres de gran valor"*



Requirements: Fully initiated into the Catholic church (have made Confirmation) and in full communion with the Catholic church (Able to receive communion). Adequately prepare and be able to read and proclaim scripture by speaking clearly and audibly.

**Training to be a Eucharistic Minister** will be after each Mass for 45 minutes on Sat. **March 26th**, and Sun. **March 27th**. Just attend one.

**Requirements:** Fully initiated into the Catholic church (have made Confirmation) and in full communion with the Catholic church (Able to receive communion). Love and values the Eucharist and wants to give the Body and Blood of Christ to others. Feeling worthy is not a condition of employment.


